1 **VIRGIN TOWN** 2 ORDINANCE NO. 2025-3 AMENDING STANDARDS FOR OPEN SPACE ZONE 4 5 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 16 OF THE VIRGIN MUNICIPAL CODE TO AMEND 6 AND RENUMBER THE CHAPTER GOVERNING OPEN SPACE DISTRICT 7 8 WHEREAS, Virgin Town ("the Town") is a Utah municipal corporation and political 9 subdivision of the State of Utah, and 10 WHEREAS, the Virgin Town Council ("Town Council") is the legislative and 11 12 governing body of the Town, and 13 14 WHEREAS, the Town Council with advice of the Virgin Town Planning and Zoning 15 Commission ("Planning Commission"), in addition to being the legislative and governing body of the Town, is also the Land Use Authority ("LUA") vested with the 16 17 power to enact all Land Use Regulations and make all Land Use Decisions within the 18 Town unless the latter administrative power is delegated to another body or person, 19 and 20 21 WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on this ordinance on 22 November 12, 2025; and 23 24 WHEREAS, the Virgin Town Planning and Zoning Commission voted to on a motion to recommend that Town Council approve these amendments on May 25 26 13,2025; and 27 28 WHEREAS, Virgin Town contains lands which have been and remain in Open Space 29 District since substantially prior to 2021, and 30 31 WHEREAS, prior to 2021, Virgin's Land Use code included a chapter describing 32 standards and uses for that zone, and 33 34 WHEREAS, an amendment to the code was made in 2021 which, perhaps 35 erroneously, removed the entire Chapter 48 Open Space District, and 36 37 WHEREAS, Virgin Town officials require guidance as to uses and standards for lands 38 currently zoned Open Space, and 39 40 WHEREAS, Virgin's LUA finds it to be in the best interests of the health, safety, and 41 welfare of residents and visitors to the Town to replace the missing section of the Land 42 Use code; 43 44 WHEREAS, comments from the Virgin Town Council on a previous version of this ordinance prompted this revision to include, among other things, a list of prohibited 45 46 uses;
