

COMMISSION WORKSESSION

October 13, 2025

Minutes of a scheduled worksession of the Sevier County Commission held this thirteenth day of October 2025. Meeting commenced at 10:30 a.m. with Commissioners Scott Johnson, Greg Jensen, and Ralph Brown in the Conference Room, Room 116, of the Sevier County Administration Building, 250 North Main, Richfield, Utah. Clerk/Auditor Steven Wall and Executive Director Malcolm Nash were also present.

Communications Director Johnny Parsons, Michael Parsons, and Reggie Parsons met with the Commission concerning Director Parsons upcoming retirement at the end of May 2026. Director Parsons discussed with the Commission what he has been doing with the TV repeaters, the radios for several departments. He indicated that upon his retirement most of the departments will have people to take care of the radios, but they are proposing that Reggie and Michael of MP Electronics take over his responsibilities handling the TV and radio repeaters in Sevier County buildings throughout the County, as well as Levan Peak. He indicated that in the proposed agreement with MP Electronics, they would not install the individual radios in vehicles, etc. but they would still handle the repeater stations and maintain the licensing for the County ensuring that was kept up to date. Discussion followed concerning use of the County equipment – computers, truck, trailer, UHV with trax – to be able to access the repeater stations in the winter. It was noted that the County would still be responsible to pay for the equipment and parts, etc. Further discussion followed concerning ownership of the equipment, insurance of the equipment, and maintenance of the equipment. The Commission said they would continue to work on the agreement for the next few months, noting the agreement would be less expensive for the County as they would not be covering benefits.

There being no further business to come before the Board, meeting adjourned at 11:25 a.m.
