

NOTICE OF INTENT TO OBTAIN LEASES FOR OIL AND GAS EXTRACTION ON CERTAIN PROPERTIES WITH MINERAL RIGHTS OWNED BY UINTAH COUNTY

Notice is hereby given that the Uintah County Commission will meet at 3:00 p.m. in the County Commission Chambers, 147 East Main Street, Vernal, Utah, on December 2, 2025 to conduct a Public Auction on a request to obtain leases for oil and gas extraction on certain private property with mineral rights owned by Uintah County. There are mineral rights being offered on the tract of land as follows:

1. Township 2 South, Range 1 East, USM
Section 13: Stone Subdivision Lot 5, LESS a 12.5-inch perimeter around Stone Subdivision Lot 5 Containing 2.4655 gross acres, more or less
2. Township 2 South, Range 1 East, USM
Section 17:
 - 1) A strip of land 100' wide on the left side of the center of the State Road beginning at Engineers Station 192-00 which point is more particularly described as 15' north and 300' west of the SW/4; thence S89°36' E 325 feet to Station 195-30.
