

PARKS, TRAILS, AND RECREATION COMMITTEE MINUTES

Wednesday, September 3, 2025 at 7:00 PM at 1020 East Pioneer Road, Draper, Utah 84020 in the Administration Conference Room.

1. **Approval of 2-5-2025 Minutes**– Motion by Suzanne Quick, seconded by Doug Ovard, to approve the minutes. Motion passed unanimously.
2. **E-moto Use – Issues and Potential Options** – The committee discussed the current issues with E-moto use in the city, and potential concerns with accommodating use on trails in the city. Some concerns include having adequate trail mileage; adequate trailhead parking; increased draw from the region; increased user conflicts; impacts to trails; limited maintenance resources; conservation easement restrictions. Suggestion to require information on laws with purchase of e-moto.
3. **Maple Hollow Downhill Trail Reconstruction** – Greg Hilbig reviewed planned reconstruction of sections of the trail. Committee would like to ensure that the primitive nature of the trail remains, keep as many line options open, and to upgrade the crossing with Ann’s Trail with a potential flyover. Staff to review options.
4. **Corner Canyon Half Marathon** – Greg Hilbig asked for volunteers for the upcoming half marathon on September 20th.
5. **Review: Utah Trails Conference** - Brad Jensen and Greg Hilbig reviewed items from the Utah Trails Conference they attended this past spring. Brad reviewed Universal Trail Design for adaptive mountain biking. Greg reviewed current management practices for accommodating e-bike use.
6. **Committee/Staff reports**

Committee members requested that staff look at the following trail improvements:
 - Provide off-ramp from the upper Rattle N’ Hum to Wood Hollow Trail (at the original connection point)
 - Provide a return loop to allow sessions on Maple Hollow Downhill Trail.
 - Small bridge or drainage improvement for continuous wet spot by meadow on Ghost Falls Trail.
Geneva Woodmansee stated that the residents in the Hidden Canyon subdivision are requesting the city proceed forward with the planned neighborhood park located by the large basin at the top of Hog Hollow.
7. **Adjournment** - Motion by Doug Anderson, seconded by Geneva Woodmansee to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed unanimously.
