Meeting was called to order at 6:30 P.M. by Mayor Greg Pearson.

Minutes for the September 2025 meeting were reviewed.

Mayor Greg Pearson discussed the CIB grant for the roads. He stated that the town was awarded 1.75 million dollars and the town will pay an additional \$150,000 so the total will be \$1.9 million dollars to repair all the roads in Junction. This will include a chip seal on Thompson Lane and the road by the Beckman's going to the piece in the back will also be chip sealed. This job will start going out for bids in January or February.

The lead pipe grant was also discussed. The town received \$41,200 in grant to help with this process.

Councilman LeRell Barnson talked about a water project that he would like to work on. He stated that Kelly Chappell says they would have to collect from the property owners and Junction can do the grant and adopt the project. This would mean that the town would have to hold a public hearing and have the property owners come to review the project. More to discuss later.

Time was turned to Mayor Greg Pearson to report on the fire department. He stated that there was a small fire up Kingston Canyon that was caused by a blown tire and started a few brush fires. That was all he had to report.

Overdue water bills were discussed. The clerk will need to send out letters of concerns to all those on the list and also one disconnect notice.

Councilman LeRell Barnson stated that he is at 30,000 gallons for water and will make a payment.

Councilman Coy Morrison stated that they are under 30,000 gallons of water and will also make a payment.

The cemetery was discussed. Councilman Sherm Buck stated that he needs to check on the grant project to see what to do and where to start.

The airport was discussed. The weeds need to be sprayed again and he will check on that. The drag races that just happened but got rained out.

The financial statement and bank statement for the month of September were available for review.
