Laddy from Intermark Steel reported on their use of the grant money, they purchased 10 newer welding machines, increasing their fabricated steel output and employee count from 20 to 26. Last year they spent over \$1.3 million on new equipment and shop expansions, with plans for two more expansions, including a fiber laser machine and

Economic Assistance Grant, managed through her office, will reopen from September 1st to September 15th. There is \$4.5 million available for qualifying businesses and nonprofits. The grant is project-based and does not cover operating costs.
