A RESOLUTION OF THE MILITARY INSTALLATION DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY BOARD ("MIDA") THANKING RYAN STARKS FOR HIS SERVICE ON THE MIDA BOARD AND APPOINTING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY JEFFERSON MOSS AS A NONVOTING MEMBER OF THE MIDA BOARD

WHEREAS, §63H-1-302(5) Utah Code Annotated 1953 ("UCA"), as amended provides that the MIDA Board may "appoint nonvoting members of the board" and the board may "set terms for nonvoting members"; and

WHEREAS, Ryan Starks has been serving as a nonvoting board member since 2022 representing the Governor's Office of Economic Opportunity ("GOEO"), where he has served with distinction; and

WHEREAS, Ryan Starks recently departed his role as Executive Director of GOEO in order to pursue other professional opportunities; and

WHEREAS, Jefferson Moss has since been appointed by the Governor to serve as the new Executive Director of GOEO, replacing Ryan Starks; and

WHEREAS; Jefferson Moss has a wealth of knowledge and experience and as Executive Director has the ability to provide coordination with GOEO and the State of Utah; and

WHEREAS, MIDA finds that having the Executive Director of GOEO serve on the board will continue to help coordinate MIDA's military-focused economic development with GOEO's broader economic development efforts for Utah;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MIDA BOARD that:

- 1. The Board expresses its deep appreciation to Ryan Starks for his years of service to MIDA, and the Board wishes him well as he embarks on new professional endeavors.
- 2. Jefferson Moss is appointed as a nonvoting member of the MIDA Board for the remainder of the GOEO Executive Director term, which expires in March 2027, and thereafter for a subsequent four year term which shall automatically renew until a new appointment is made.
