Whereas the Board of Trustees are the board of Canvassers for Jensen Water Improvement District, and


Whereas on November 17, 2025, the Board canvassed the municipal election results by determining the votes for each person.


Therefore, it is hereby resolved by the Jensen Water Improvement District Board of Trustee Canvassers as follows:


