Chair Shelley Brennan called the meeting to order at 11:36 am.

Rick Maloy, Project Coordinator, gave an update to the Board on the Integrated Water Supply Plan. He explained to the Board that the purpose of the plan is to guide the District's future water management decisions in a manner that will address uncertainties related to growth, climate change, and other factors that produce vulnerabilities in water supplies. He reviewed key milestones from 2025, the detailed work plan, and the tasks that are planned for 2026.

Marty Larson, Highline Canal Company

Amanda Strack, Water Conservation Manager, gave a brief update on the District's Conservation Plan, which is due for an update this year. She stated that the draft plan will be shared with the Board next month, and the Board will be asked to adopt it by resolution.

Matt Geddes from Squire and Co. reported their findings for the 2024-2025 Audit. He stated that they offered a clean opinion, using Federal and State compliance standards. Matt stated that the District's new finance system did not cause any problems with the audit. He then shared that the audit is still in draft form due to the government shutdown, as the OMB has not released the

final Federal compliance supplement. He anticipates there will be no issues with the District's audit when the OMB issues the final supplement.

Roger Pearson, CUPCA Special Programs Manager, presented information to the Board relating to working with Strawberry Water Users and Highline Canal Company. He stated that Resolution 2025-10-11 authorizes and directs District staff to work with partners to pursue the reassignment of SVP facilities to Bonneville Unit facilities. Roger shared that this is part of the NWP, and enclosing the Highline Canal is also part of the plan.

General Manager Gene Shawcroft thanked General Managers Marty Larsen from Highline Canal Company and Sterling Brown from the Strawberry Water Users Association for their collaborative work with the District. He indicated that this collaboration is important and will help South Utah County for years to come.

There were no committee reports.
