

NOTICE OF ELECTION 2026 REGULAR GENERAL ELECTION

Please take notice that candidates are to be elected for the following offices at the General Election to be held in Garfield County on Tuesday, November 3rd, 2026.

The Declaration of Candidacy filing period for qualified political party candidates begins Friday, January 2, 2026 and ends at 5:00 p.m. Thursday, January 8, 2026.

The Declaration of Candidacy filing period for local board of education candidates begins Friday, January 2, 2026 and ends at 5:00 p.m. Thursday, January 8, 2026.

The Declaration of Candidacy filing period for justices and judges of a court of record begins Wednesday, July 1, 2026 and ends at 5:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 15th, 2026.

The Declaration of Intent to Gather Signatures period for qualified political party candidates begins Friday, January 2nd, 2026 and ends at 5:00 p.m. Thursday, January 8, 2026.

Qualified political party candidates must submit nomination petition signatures no later than 14 days before the day on which the qualified political party holds its convention to select candidates for the elective office.

Registered political party candidates must submit nomination petition signatures no later than 5:00 p.m. Tuesday, March 31st, 2026.

The Declaration of Candidacy filing period for candidates not affiliated with a political party begins on Friday, January 2nd, 2026 at 8:00 a.m. and ends at 5:00 p.m. Monday, June 15th, 2026.

Candidates not affiliated with a political party must submit certificates of nomination no later than 5:00 p.m., Monday, June 15, 2026.

1. FEDERAL

- a. U.S. House of Representatives.** One Representative for a two (2) year term in each of the following U.S. Congressional District:

Third District. The Third District consists of Beaver, Carbon, Dagget, Duchesne, Emery, Garfield, Grand, Iron, Kane, Morgan, Piute, San Juan, Summit, Uintah, Wasatch, Washington, and Wayne Counties as well as portions of Utah and Weber Counties.

2. STATE

- a. **State House of Representatives.** One member of the Utah House of Representatives for a two (2) year term from each State Legislative District.

District Sixty-nine (69) consists of Garfield, Grand, Kane, San Juan, and Wayne Counties as well as a portion of Emery County.

3. JUDICIAL

- a. **Supreme Court.** There will be a retention election for two (2) Supreme Court Judge, provided that the incumbent whose term is expiring files during the filing period.
- b. **Court of Appeals.** There will be a retention election for six (6) Court of Appeals Judges, provided that the incumbent whose term is expiring files during the filing period.
- c. **District Court.** There will be a retention election for one (1) District Court Judge in the following district, provided that the incumbent(s) whose term is expiring files during the filing period:

Sixth District. One (1) Judge in the Sixth Judicial District, which consists of Garfield, Kane, Piute, Sanpete, Sevier, and Wayne Counties.

- d. **Juvenile Court.** There will be a retention election for one (1) Juvenile Court Judge in the following district, provided that the incumbent(s) whose term is expiring files during the filing period:

Sixth District. One (1) Judge in the Sixth Judicial District, which consists of Garfield, Kane, Piute, Sanpete, Sevier, and Wayne Counties.

4. COUNTY

- a. **Commission Seat A** - One member for a four (4) year term.
- b. **Commission Seat B** - One member for a four (4) year term.
- c. **Attorney** -One member for a four (4) year term
- d. **Clerk/Auditor** - One member for a four (4) year term.
- e. **Sheriff** - One member for a four (4) year term.

5. **SCHOOL BOARD**

- a. **Garfield County School Board.** One member for a four (4) year term from each of the following districts.
 - i. **School Board District #4.** District #4 consists of Bryce Canyon City Precinct, Cannonville Precinct, Henrieville Precinct, and Tropic Precinct.
 - ii. **School Board District #5.** District #5 consists of Antimony Precinct, Boulder Precinct, Hatch Precinct, and Ticaboo Precinct.
