3. Agenda Items

3.a Draper Historical Society Coordination

Annie reached out to Korral Broschinsky about creating a nomination for the Isaac Stewart House but never heard back. The Isaac Stewart nomination will be on the next budget time.

3.d America 250 update

Kellie Challburg provided an update on the City Council discussion. The Council was in favor of joining the America250 Utah events. Kellie said the proclamation will be approved by the end of the year and will give the City \$1,500. The Council talked about community involvement in events. They talked about 250 kids in the Draper Days parade with flags. As for having a potluck, the City has reserved every pavilion in the City for this. Draper City will provide drinks. They suggested walking or biking 250 miles, planting 250 trees, and a coloring contest for kids. They hope to take advantage of other activities already happening

in the City to do these things. Kellie and Councilmember Bryn Johnson went to a class downtown about the America250 Utah events.

3.e Walking Tour Brochures

David received his first rejection for placing a stand with walking tour brochures from Corner Canyon Dental. He was able to leave a container at Draper Park Middle school. New containers have arrived and between now and the next meeting he will get more out.

3.f Galena Soo'nkahni Preserve Website Page Update

Wendy let the Commission know that the information has been posted on the city website. She wants to work with the City to ensure that it lives on the website in the same place where other historic properties are. She then talked about the importance of the Utah State Historic Preservation Office's Cultural Site Stewardship Program. James Toledo, Director of Utah Division of Indian Affairs, talked about stewardship when the monument was created.

3.g Draper Ethnic and Minority History Research

David stated he had nothing to report.

3.h Walk-through Video Tour of Historic Homes

Nancy and Melissa Day went to see the Aurelius W. Fitzgerald House last week at 12934 S Fort St. The owner, Jeannette Wilson, is doing restoration work and wants to wait to do a video tour until after the restoration work is done. She is providing photos during the restoration and before. Dana Fisher in the Smith/Rasmussen House next to Draper Historic Theater at 12376 900 East said they would be good with doing a video tour in March 2026. We asked Deena Williams if November 1st or 8th late morning would be good to tour her home on Pioneer Rd. She said November 8th. Commission members will be going there at 11:00am that day.
