

RESOLUTION NO. 20-2025
A RESOLUTION APPROVING MEMBER CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE UTAH
RETIREMENT SYSTEMS CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT PLAN FISCAL YEAR
2026-2027; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Section 1. Recitals

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Weber Fire District (the “District”) finds that the District is a Local District created as a Service Area, a body politic and subdivision of the State of Utah, that provides fire protection and emergency services to the owners of certain real property and has distinct boundaries; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees finds that certain sections of Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended, authorizes public bodies, including the District, to establish written procedures governing the general administration of the District including personnel, insurance, retirement, and related matters; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees finds that it becomes necessary from time to time to amend, change, or delete certain written policies and procedures to conform with current statute changes, personnel issues, retirement, and state and federal rule changes; and,

WHEREAS, the Weber Fire District participates in the Utah Retirement System for all eligible employees; and

WHEREAS, the Weber Fire District contributes to the Utah Retirement Contributory Retirement Plan as allowed; and

WHEREAS, the District seeks to follow legislative efforts regarding member contributions to the Utah Retirement Systems Contributory Retirement Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees finds that the public convenience and necessity, public safety, health and welfare is at issue in this matter; now,

Section 2. NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE WEBER FIRE DISTRICT BOARD OF TRUSTEES:

That Weber Fire District formally agrees to fund (“pick-up”) the required member contribution for all eligible employees required to contribute to the Utah Retirement Systems Contributory Retirement Plan for the 2026-2027 Fiscal Year (effective July 1, 2026) according to the applicable Utah Retirement Systems Retirement Contribution Rates.

Section 3. REPEALER OF CONFLICTING ENACTMENTS:

All orders and resolutions with respect to the changes herein enacted and adopted which have heretofore been adopted by the District, or parts thereof, which are in conflict with any of the provisions of this Resolution, are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed, except that this repeal shall not be construed to revive any act, order or resolution, or part thereof, heretofore repealed.

Section 4. PRIOR RESOLUTIONS:

The body and substance of any and all prior Resolutions, together with their specific provisions, where not otherwise in conflict with this Resolution, are hereby reaffirmed and readopted.

Section 5. SAVINGS CLAUSE:

If any provision of this Resolution shall be held or deemed to be or shall, in fact, be invalid, inoperative or unenforceable for any reason, such reason shall not have the effect of rendering any other provision or provisions hereof invalid, inoperative or unenforceable to any extent whatever, this Resolution and the provisions of this Resolution being deemed to be the separate independent and severable act of The Board of Trustees of District.

SECTION 6. DATE OF EFFECT:

This Resolution shall be effective on the 9th day of December, 2025, and after publication or posting as required by law.
