**REGULAR AGENDA ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION:**


**PUBLIC HEARING: EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION INCREASES FOR 2025**

The Clerk/Auditor explained that county employees may be eligible to receive up to \$1,000 in additional compensation depending on factors including service, employment classification, standing and total hours worked. Pursuant to S.B. 91 any compensation increase awarded to an executive county officer must be publicly disclosed and subject to a public hearing.
