

GRAMA Claim of Business Confidentiality

Pursuant to Utah Code Section [63G-2-305](#)(1) and (2), and in accordance with Section [63G-2-309](#), Riverside Farm (company name) asserts a claim of business confidentiality to protect the following information submitted as part of a Request for Proposals.

- non-public financial statements
- specific employee name and contact information
- specific customer information, client lists, or subscription lists
- other (specify):

Renwal application contains proprietary information, specific employee job titles, direct phone numbers, personal cell phone numbers, and personal email addresses used for company business

This claim is asserted because this information requires protection as it includes:

trade secrets as defined in Utah Code Section [13-24-2](#) ("Trade secret" means information, including a formula, pattern, compilation, program, device, method, technique, or process, that: (a) derives independent economic value, actual or potential, from not being generally known to, and not being readily ascertainable by proper means by, other persons who can obtain economic value from its disclosure or use; and (b) is the subject of efforts that are reasonable under the circumstances to maintain its secrecy.)

commercial information or non-individual financial information obtained from a person if: (a) disclosure of the information could reasonably be expected to result in unfair competitive injury to the person submitting the information or would impair the ability of the governmental entity to obtain necessary information in the future; [and] (b) the person submitting the information has a greater interest in prohibiting access than the public in obtaining access.

Following is a concise statement of reasons supporting the claim of business confidentiality:

The identified employee names, job titles, direct contact telephone numbers, and personal email addresses constitute confidential commercial information. Public disclosure of this information would reveal the company's internal organizational structure and key personnel responsible for performance of the contract, enabling competitors to directly target and recruit these employees or disrupt ongoing business relationships. Additionally, release of personal contact information creates substantial privacy and security risks to the individuals (including unwanted solicitation and harassment) and could impair the company's ability to attract and retain qualified staff in future procurements. Riverside Farm LLC maintains strict internal policies limiting distribution of this information and has a significantly greater interest in protecting it than the public has in accessing individual employee contact details.
