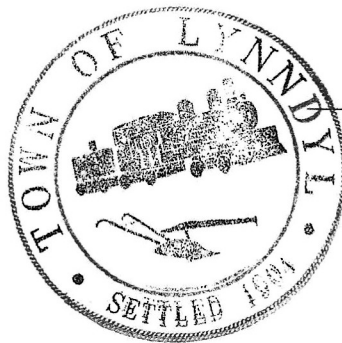
Mayor Proctor called the meeting to order and asked for a review of the minutes of July's meeting. Miff made a motion to approve the minutes and Richard seconded.

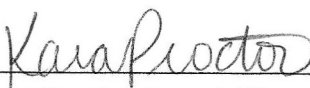
Time was first given to Kay Stowell who wanted to discuss water rates for the town. She is upset that they are so high.
