




Based on our discussion (Tuesday, November 18, 2025) it is understood that the Santa Clara City Council is considering lowering the speed limit on Santa Clara Drive from the current posted speed of 30 MPH down to 25 MPH. Roadways are typically designed with criteria set for a given maximum vehicle velocity (called design speed). Constructing the roadway within design speed parameters helps ensure the roadway can be negotiated safely by typical passenger or commercial vehicles at or below the prescribed design speed. While traffic speed adjustments are fully within a governing body's jurisdiction, arbitrarily raising or lowering speeds, without investigative study or implementing appropriate physical countermeasures, could lead to driver disregard if they perceive the roadway could be traveled safely at a higher speed.

The suggested measures we discussed (i.e., LED flashing speed limit signs with associated advanced warning signs, and a raised center median on the east leg of Santa Clara Drive at the Vernons Street intersection) are all valid and usually effective traffic calming and safety improvement techniques. Each of these measures can be implemented without significant cost. Other, more costly improvements could be considered on a case-by-case basis, should further methods be needed to accomplish the speed management goals for Santa Clara Drive.

Other traffic calming measures that could be implemented as funding permits:

- Lane narrowing—reduce travel lane widths to 11 feet and widen the bicycle lanes to 5 feet (each side). This option requires removal of the inside bike lane stripe by sandblasting or mechanical grinding, then restriping the bike lane one-foot into the vehicle travel lane.
- Construct “Chicanes” in the straight sections of Santa Clara Drive (between Gates Lane and Vernons Street and between Old Farm Road and Heights Drive). Chicanes require vehicles to laterally shift positions to follow lane alignments which helps reduce speeds.
- Construct a “Mini Roundabout” at the intersection of Santa Clara Drive and Vernons Street. Roundabouts are shown to provide slight speed reduction. In this case, the central island and splitter islands of a mini roundabout are fully traversable so large delivery trucks (fruit stand) can turn left by driving over the central island.

Examples of some of these suggested countermeasures are attached.

If the city proceeds with lowering the speed along Santa Clara Drive, the new speed limit should be supported by roadway design and operations and a level of enforcement necessary to achieve speed limit credibility and compliance among the majority of road users.


Chicane

Description:

- A series of alternating curves or lane shifts that force a motorist to steer back and forth instead of traveling a straight path
- Also called deviations, serpentines, reversing curves, or twists

Applications:

- Appropriate for mid-block locations but can be an entire block if it is relatively short
- Most effective with equivalent low volumes on both approaches
- Appropriate speed limit is typically 35 mph or less
- Typically, a series of at least three landscaped curb extensions
- Can use alternating on-street parking from one side of a street to the other
- Applicable on one-lane one-way and two-lane two-way roadways
- Can be used with either open or closed (i.e. curb and gutter) cross-section
- Can be used with or without a bicycle facility

Design/Installation Issues:

- Chicanes may still permit speeding by drivers cutting straight paths across the center line
- Minimize relocation of drainage features
- May force bicyclists to share travel lanes with motor vehicles
- Maintain sufficient width for ease of emergency vehicles and truck throughput

Potential Impacts:

- No effect on access, although heavy trucks may experience challenges when negotiating
- Limited data available on impacts to speed and crash risk
- Street sweeping may need to be done manually
- Minimal anticipated volume diversion from street
- May require removal of some on-street parking
- Provides opportunity for landscaping
- Unlikely to require utility relocation
- Not a preferred crosswalk location
- Bus passengers may experience discomfort due to quick successive lateral movements

Emergency Response Issues:

- Appropriate along primary emergency vehicle routes

Typical Cost (2017 dollars):

- Reported costs range between \$8,000 and \$25,000


Mini Roundabout

Description:

- Raised islands, placed in unsignalized intersections, around which traffic circulates
- Motorists yield to motorists already in the intersection
- Require drivers to slow to a speed that allows them to comfortably maneuver around them
- Center island of mini roundabout is fully traversable, splitter islands may be fully traversable

Applications:

- Intersections of local and/or collector streets
- One lane each direction entering intersection
- Not typically used at intersections with high volume of large trucks or buses turning left
- Appropriate for low-speed settings

Design/Installation:

- See NCHRP Report 672 for design details
- Typically circular in shape, but may be an oval shape
- Controlled by YIELD signs on all approaches with pedestrian crosswalks, if included, one car-length upstream of YIELD bar
- Preferable for roadway to have urban cross section (i.e., curb and gutter)
- Can be applied to road with on-street parking
- Can be applied to roads both with and without a bicycle facility. Bicycle facilities, if provided, must be separated from the circulatory roadway with physical barriers; cyclists using the circulatory roadway must merge with vehicles. Bicycle facilities are prohibited in the circulatory roadway to prevent right-hook crashes.
- Key design features are the fastest paths and path alignment.

Potential Impacts:

- Slight speed reduction
- Little diversion of traffic
- Bicycle and motorist will share lanes at intersections because of narrowed roadway
- Large vehicles/buses usually drive over the center island for left turns

Emergency Response:

- Emergency vehicles maneuver using the center island at slow speeds

Typical Cost

- Cost is similar to bulb-outs because pedestrian ramps and outside curb lines usually have to be relocated



To be eligible to be appointed to the Black Diamond City Council, you must have continuously resided within Black Diamond city limits for a minimum of one year prior to your appointment to the Council and must be a registered voter in the City of Black Diamond.

If you hold, participate in, or are involved in any contract(s) with the City of Black Diamond or if you hold any other elected public office, please explain in your cover letter.

Please note that:

- Once a Councilmember application is filed with the City, it is a public record available to the public.
- The applications received from all candidates who meet the minimum requirements of State law, along with the answers to the supplemental questions, will be posted on the City of Black Diamond website as part of the Council's meeting packet the Friday prior to the candidate interviews.

City Council Duties & Compensation

The Black Diamond City Council is the legislative authority of the City of Black Diamond. The City operates under a Mayor-Council form of government. The City Council serves as the legislative body of the City. The Council is responsible for setting policy, adopting the annual budget, adopting laws, determining the services to be provided and the funding levels for those services, and confirming citizens to commissions.

The duties of a City Councilmember will likely involve an average minimum commitment of 18-20 hours per month for preparation, participation, and attendance at various meetings and community activities. Beyond the broad duties previously mentioned, Councilmember duties include, but are not limited to:

- Attendance is required at regular City Council meetings, which are held on the first and third Thursday of each month at 7:00 p.m. Regular Work Sessions which are held on the second Thursday of each month at 6:00 p.m., and Town Hall meetings which are held the second Thursdays in the months of March and October from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. From time to time, the City Council or Mayor may call Special City Council meetings to handle City business.
- Councilmembers are expected to serve as liaisons to the City's Commissions and on Council Standing Committees, regional boards and commissions, and to represent the City Council at various community functions. These various meetings and functions occur normally during the evenings, but may also occur on some weekends, and during some weekdays.
- Some travel is expected locally, regionally, and/or within the State of Washington, involving various organizations of which the City of Black Diamond is a member. Councilmembers may also at their discretion, travel and attend training, education and/or participate in other organizations at the local, regional, state, or in some instances on the national level. Travel, education, and training expenses for local, regional, state, and national activities are reimbursed in accordance with City policy applicable to all employees and city officials, subject to the budgetary limit set for the City Council as a whole.

The monthly Councilmember salary is \$160 per month.

1. Why do you want to serve on the City Council?
2. What experiences, talents or skills do you bring to the Council and community that you would like to highlight?

City Council Appointment Information and Application

Councilmember Role

The City Council, as the legislative body of the City, establishes local laws and policies, consistent with State law, through the enactment of ordinances and resolutions. City Councilmembers also serve as liaisons to the City's numerous Boards and Commissions and represent the City on various intergovernmental boards and committees.

City Council Appointments

The City Council is elected at-large, and Councilmembers serve staggered four-year terms. A council appointment occurs when a councilmember leaves office before their term has ended and council appoints someone to fill that position. Mountlake Terrace residents may apply to be appointed by the City Council to fill the vacancy until the end of the term, December 2025. If the appointee wishes to continue serving as a councilmember beyond that, they will need file in May to run in the November 2025 election to begin a new term in 2026.

Councilmember Requirements

Candidates must be at least 18 years of age, a U. S. citizen, and a registered voter in the City of Mountlake Terrace. Candidates must also reside in Mountlake Terrace and have done so for at least the last year.

Councilmember Terms and Meeting Attendance

The City Council body consists of seven positions, each having a four-year term. The City Council meets regularly on the first four Thursdays of each month beginning at 7:00 p.m. Special meetings are called when needed. Three consecutive, unexcused absences result in forfeiture of office.

Councilmember Compensation

In 2025, members of the City Council receive \$1,003 per month as payment for their services and to reimburse out-of-pocket expenses related to regular duties and responsibilities. The Mayor, who is elected from among the City Councilmembers for a two-year term, receives the sum of \$1,277 per month.

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-24R

A RESOLUTION OF IVINS CITY, UTAH, ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES TO FILL THE 2026 CITY COUNCIL SEAT MIDTERM VACANCY CREATED BY THE RESIGNATION OF KEVIN SMITH TO ASSUME THE DUTIES OF IVINS CITY MAYOR

WHEREAS pursuant to the results of the 2025 Ivins City Municipal election it is anticipated that Councilmember Kevin Smith will be resigning his council member position effective as of January 5, 2026, to assume the duties of Ivins City Mayor, leaving a vacancy on the Ivins City Council;

WHEREAS after Kevin Smith resigns his council member seat just under 2 years will be left on the term of office for that city council seat;

WHEREAS Utah Code Section 20A-1-510 governs how the Ivins City Council can fill a midterm vacancy and allows the Ivins City Council to, "consistent with the provisions of state law, adopt procedures governing the appointment, interview and voting process for filling the vacancy." UCA 20A-1-510(7);

WHEREAS the Ivins City Council values transparency, openness and fairness in how the vacancy will be filled

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Ivins City as follows:

Vacancy Procedures. The Ivins City Council will follow the following procedures to fill the vacancy in a city council seat created by the resignation of Kevin Smith to assume the duties of Mayor effective as of January 5, 2026:

1. **Notice of Vacancy.** The City shall publish the notice of vacancy required by UCA 20A-1-510(1)(c) on or before Tuesday, November 25, 2025, specifying as follows:
 - a. The vacancy will be filled by the City Council at the regular Ivins City Council meeting scheduled for January 15, 2026, commencing at 5:30 p.m. (the "Vacancy Meeting").
 - b. Interested individuals who are qualified by law to serve as city council members ("Candidates") shall submit their name, campaign finance statement and conflict of interest disclosure statement to Kari D. Jimenez, City Recorder, on or before December 19th, 2025 at 5:00 p.m. (the "Submission Deadline").
 - c. On or before the Submission Deadline, Candidates may complete and submit additional materials consisting of no more than the application attached hereto as Exhibit A, written answers to the questions attached hereto as Exhibit B, a statement of interest, a resume, and up to 3 letters of recommendation. No Candidate is required to submit any items of additional information but submission is highly encouraged so that the City Council will have additional information to consider for each Candidate before the interviews. No other materials will be considered. All materials submitted by Candidates will be public records available with the agenda for the Vacancy Meeting, except that home addresses, telephone numbers, and email addresses will be redacted.

2. **Pre-Vacancy Meeting Actions.** After the Submission Deadline, but before the Vacancy Meeting, all those individuals who will be entitled to vote to fill the vacancy (i.e., any City Council members serving as of the Vacancy Meeting and Kevin Smith (pursuant to UCA 20A-1-510(4)(a) (allowing the resigning council member to participate in the interview and vote on the replacement), the “Voting Quorum”) may do any of the following:
 - a. Review the submitted materials from all Candidates.
 - b. Submit to the City Recorder any questions to be asked of the Candidates at the Vacancy Meeting for HR and legal approval. The City Recorder will compile a master list of all questions.
3. **Vacancy Meeting Interviews.** All Candidates must attend the Vacancy Meeting and answer questions from the Voting Quorum. All Candidates present will be randomly assigned a Candidate Number by drawing a number from a hat, numbered from 1 to the total number of Candidates. Questions will be asked as follows:
 - a. Each Candidate will, in numerical order, be allowed to 2 minutes to present an opening statement to introduce themselves and present an opening statement in favor of their candidacy.
 - b. Each Candidate will take turns answering specific questions until all members of the Voting Quorum indicate they are done asking Specific Questions. The Mayor will call each Candidate to the podium in reverse numerical order and will allow members of the Voting Quorum to ask specific questions until no more specific questions remain for that Candidate. This will be repeated until all specific questions have been asked.
 - c. After the Specific Questions, each Candidate will, in reverse numerical order, be allowed 2 minutes to present a concluding statement in favor of their Candidacy.
4. **Vacancy Meeting Discussion.** After the Interviews and concluding statements have ended, the members of the Voting Quorum may discuss the merits of the Candidates. In so discussing, the members of the Voting Quorum should take care to not specifically identify the Candidate for whom they intend to vote but shall instead focus on the strengths or weaknesses of each Candidate. This is intended to allow each member of the Voting Quorum to vote based primarily on the merits of the Candidates and not solely based on how another member of the Voting Quorum votes. Of course, it may become apparent during the discussion how a member of the Voting Quorum will likely vote. Such disclosure in any form will not invalidate any subsequent vote.
5. **Initial Vote.** At any time during the discussion of the Candidates under Section 4 above, any member of the Voting Quorum may move to proceed to an initial vote. If the motion is not seconded or fails to secure a majority of the members of the Voting Quorum, the discussion will continue. If the motion is seconded and a majority of the members of the Voting Quorum vote in favor of the motion, the discussion will end and each member of the Voting Quorum shall each select one Candidate in writing on a written ballot provided by the City Recorder. Once all members of the Voting Quorum have voted, the City Recorder will tabulate the results and announce which Candidates have received votes and how many votes

they received. If a Candidate receives a majority votes (3 or more), that Candidate will be declared the winner and will be sworn in as a member of the City Council.

6. **Narrowing of Candidates.** If no Candidate receives a majority vote, the two Candidates who have received the most votes will proceed to a final vote. If two Candidates are tied for second place, the tie shall be broken by a single coin flip conducted by the City Recorder. If three or more Candidates are tied for second place, the ties shall be broken by a series of coin flips between each of the Candidates where each Candidate will participate in one flip involving each other tied Candidate. At the conclusion of the series, the candidate with the most "wins" shall be declared the second place Candidate. If Candidates remain tied for second place after the series of flips, any Candidates no longer tied will be dismissed and the remaining Candidates will undergo another coin flip (for a tie among just two Candidates) or series of coin flips (for ties among three or more Candidates) until just one candidate remains who will then be declared the second place Candidate.

For each coin flip, the Candidate with the higher Candidate number shall be deemed "heads" and the other Candidate shall be deemed "tails." To be a valid flip, the coin must land on the floor and come to rest without any human intervention. The coin hitting any inanimate object will not invalidate the flip. The City Recorder will inspect the coin once it comes to rest and declare which side landed up and then shall allow any other person to view the coin to confirm which side landed up. The coin shall not be touched by any person, including the City Recorder, until all individuals desiring to view it have done so.

7. **Second Discussion Period.** Once only two candidates remain, the members of the Voting Quorum may discuss the merits of the remaining Candidates in the same manner as described in Section 4 above.
8. **Final Vote.** At any time during the discussion of the Candidates under Section 7 above, any member of the Voting Quorum may move to proceed to a final vote. If the motion is not seconded or fails to secure a majority of the members of the Voting Quorum, the discussion will continue. If the motion is seconded and a majority of the members of the Voting Quorum vote in favor of the motion, the discussion will end and each member of the Voting Quorum shall each select one Candidate in writing on a written ballot provided by the City Recorder. Once all members of the Voting Quorum have voted, the City Recorder will tabulate the results and announce who received the majority of the votes and the number of votes they received. If a Candidate receives a majority votes (3 or more), that Candidate will be declared the winner and will be sworn in as a member of the City Council. If no candidate receives a majority of votes the Candidate who wins will be determined by a single coin flip pursuant to the same procedures as outlined in Section 6 above.

Open Meeting. Steps 3 through 8 above shall be taken in an open meeting. No closed meeting will be allowed.

Procedure. The procedure outlined in this resolution supersedes any conflicting procedures contained in any other rules of procedure for the City Council.

Potential Postponement. The City Council reserves the right, upon proper notice, to continue the Vacancy Meeting if any of the Voting Quorum are unable to attend or participate electronically for any reason.

Amendment. The City Council reserves the right to adjust these procedures based on a large number of candidates, which number would, in the City Council's sole discretion, require more compact procedures to be feasibly completed in one meeting.

Severability. If any section, clause, or portion of this ordinance is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect.

Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage and publication.

20A-1-510 Midterm vacancies in municipal offices.

(1)

(a) As used in this section:

(i) "Vacancy," subject to Subsection (1)(a)(ii), means the same as that term is defined in Section 20A-1-102.

(ii) "Vacancy," if due to resignation, occurs:

(A) for a municipal executive, on the effective date of an irrevocable letter of resignation submitted by the municipal executive to the municipal legislative body; or

(B) for a member of a municipal legislative body, on the effective date of an irrevocable letter of resignation submitted by the member to the municipal legislative body.

(b) Except as otherwise provided in this section, if any vacancy occurs in the office of municipal executive or member of a municipal legislative body, the municipal legislative body shall, within 30 calendar days after the day on which the vacancy occurs, appoint a registered voter in the municipality who meets the qualifications for office described in Section 10-3-301 to fill the unexpired term of the vacated office.

(c) Before acting to fill the vacancy, the municipal legislative body shall:

(i) immediately notify the municipal recorder or clerk;

(ii) give public notice of the vacancy at least 14 calendar days before the day on which the municipal legislative body meets to fill the vacancy;

(iii) identify, in the notice:

(A) the date, time, and place of the meeting where the vacancy will be filled;

(B) the person to whom an individual interested in being appointed to fill the vacancy may submit the interested individual's name for consideration; and

(C) the deadline for submitting an interested individual's name; and

(iv) in an open meeting, interview each individual whose name is submitted for consideration, and who meets the qualifications for office, regarding the individual's qualifications.

(d)

(i) The municipal legislative body shall take an initial vote to fill the vacancy from among the names of the candidates interviewed under Subsection (1)(c)(iv).

(ii)

(A) If no candidate receives a majority vote of the municipal legislative body in the initial vote described in Subsection (1)(d)(i), the two candidates that received the most votes in the initial vote, as determined by the tie-breaking procedures described in Subsections (1)(d)(ii)(B) through (D) if necessary, shall be placed before the municipal legislative body for a second vote to fill the vacancy.

(B) If the initial vote results in a tie for second place, the candidates tied for second place shall be reduced to one by a coin toss conducted in accordance with Subsection (1)(d)(ii)(D), and the second vote described in Subsection (1)(d)(ii)(A) shall be between the candidate that received the most votes in the initial vote and the candidate that wins the coin toss described in this Subsection (1)(d)(ii)(B).

(C) If the initial vote results in a tie among three or more candidates for first place, the candidates tied for first place shall be reduced to two by a coin toss conducted in accordance with Subsection (1)(d)(ii)(D), and the second vote described in Subsection (1)(d)(ii)(A) shall be between the two candidates that remain after the coin toss described in this Subsection (1)(d)(ii)(C).

(D) A coin toss required under this Subsection (1)(d) shall be conducted by the municipal clerk or recorder in the presence of the municipal legislative body.

- (iii) If, in the second vote described in Subsection (1)(d)(ii)(A), neither candidate receives a majority vote of the municipal legislative body, the vacancy shall be determined by a coin toss between the two candidates in accordance with Subsection (1)(d)(ii)(D).
- (e) If the municipal legislative body does not timely comply with Subsections (1)(b) through (d), the municipal clerk or recorder shall immediately notify the lieutenant governor.
- (f) After receiving notice that a municipal legislative body has failed to timely comply with Subsections (1)(b) through (d), the lieutenant governor shall:
 - (i) notify the municipal legislative body of the violation; and
 - (ii) direct the municipal legislative body to, within 30 calendar days after the day on which the lieutenant governor provides the notice described in this Subsection (1)(f), appoint an eligible individual to fill the vacancy in accordance with Subsections (1)(c) and (d).
- (g) If the municipality fails to timely comply with a directive described in Subsection (1)(f):
 - (i) the lieutenant governor shall notify the governor of the municipality's failure to fill the vacancy; and
 - (ii) the governor shall, within 45 calendar days after the day on which the governor receives the notice described in Subsection (1)(g)(i), provide public notice soliciting candidates to fill the vacancy in accordance with Subsection (1)(c) and appoint an individual to fill the vacancy.

(2)

- (a) A vacancy in the office of municipal executive or member of a municipal legislative body shall be filled by an interim appointment, followed by an election to fill a two-year term, if:
 - (i) the vacancy occurs, or a letter of resignation is received, by the municipal executive at least 14 calendar days before the deadline for filing for election in an odd-numbered year; and
 - (ii) two years of the vacated term will remain after the first Monday of January following the next municipal election.
- (b) In appointing an interim replacement, the municipal legislative body shall:
 - (i) comply with the notice requirements of this section; and
 - (ii) in an open meeting, interview each individual whose name is submitted for consideration, and who meets the qualifications for office, regarding the individual's qualifications.

(3)

- (a) In a municipality operating under the council-mayor form of government, as defined in Section 10-3b-102:
 - (i) the council may appoint an individual to fill a vacancy in the office of mayor before the effective date of the mayor's resignation by making the effective date of the appointment the same as the effective date of the mayor's resignation; and
 - (ii) if a vacancy in the office of mayor occurs before the effective date of an appointment under Subsection (1) or (2) to fill the vacancy, the remaining council members, by majority vote, shall appoint a council member to serve as acting mayor during the time between the creation of the vacancy and the effective date of the appointment to fill the vacancy.
- (b) A council member serving as acting mayor under Subsection (3)(a)(ii) continues to:
 - (i) act as a council member; and
 - (ii) vote at council meetings.

(4)

- (a)
 - (i) For a vacancy of a member of a municipal legislative body as described in this section, the municipal legislative body member whose resignation creates the vacancy on the municipal legislative body may:
 - (A) interview an individual whose name is submitted for consideration under Subsection (1)(c)(iv) or (2)(b)(ii); and

- (B) vote on the appointment of an individual to fill the vacancy.
- (ii) Notwithstanding Subsection (4)(a)(i), a member of a legislative body who is removed from office in accordance with state law may not cast a vote under Subsection (4)(a)(i).
- (b) A member of a municipal legislative body who submits his or her resignation to the municipal legislative body may not rescind the resignation.
- (c) A member of a municipal legislative body may not vote on an appointment under this section for himself or herself to fill a vacancy in the municipal legislative body.
- (5) In a municipality operating under the council-mayor form of government, the mayor may not:
 - (a) participate in the vote to fill a vacancy;
 - (b) veto a decision of the council to fill a vacancy; or
 - (c) vote in the case of a tie.
- (6) A mayor whose resignation from the municipal legislative body is due to election or appointment as mayor may, in the case of a tie, participate in the vote under this section.
- (7) A municipal legislative body may, consistent with the provisions of state law, adopt procedures governing the appointment, interview, and voting process for filling vacancies in municipal offices.

 - (a) Except as provided in Subsection (8)(b), an individual seeking appointment to fill a vacancy under this section shall, no later than the deadline for the individual to file a campaign finance statement under Section 10-3-208:
 - (i) complete a conflict of interest disclosure statement in accordance with Section 10-3-301.5; and
 - (ii) submit the conflict of interest disclosure statement to the municipal legislative body and the municipal clerk or recorder.
 - (b) An individual described in Subsection (8)(a) is not required to comply with Subsection (8)(a) if the individual:
 - (i) currently holds an office described in Subsection (1)(b);
 - (ii) already, that same year, filed a conflict of interest disclosure statement for the office described in Subsection (8)(b)(i), in accordance with Section 10-3-1313; and
 - (iii) no later than the deadline described in Subsection (8)(a), indicates, in a written notice submitted to the municipal clerk or recorder, that the conflict of interest disclosure statement described in Subsection (8)(b)(ii) is updated and accurate as of the date of the written notice.

 - (a) The municipal clerk or recorder shall make each conflict of interest disclosure statement made by an individual described in Subsection (8)(a) available for public inspection by posting an electronic copy of the statement on:
 - (i) the municipality's website; or
 - (ii) if the municipality does not have a website, on the website of the county in which the municipality is located.
 - (b) The municipal clerk or recorder shall:
 - (i) post the electronic statement described in Subsection (9)(a) no later than two business days after the day on which the municipal recorder or clerk receives the statement; and
 - (ii) ensure that the electronic statement remains posted on the website described in Subsection (9)(a) for at least 10 calendar days after the day on which the municipal legislative body appoints an individual to fill the vacancy.
