Write-in Candidates (20A-9-601)	Last day 5:00 p.m. Monday, August 31, 2026

Qualified Political Party Candidates must submit nomination petition signatures no later than 5:00 p.m. on the last business day that is at least 14 calendar days before the day on which the qualified political party holds its convention to select candidates for the elective office. (20A-9-408)

Registered Political Party Candidates must submit nomination petition signatures no later than 5:00 p.m. on March 31, 2026. (20A-9-403)

Candidates Not Affiliated with a Party must submit each signature packet (nomination certificate) with signatures totaling the minimum amount required for the office, to the County Clerk where the majority of the signatures in the packet were collected no later than June 15, 2026. (20A-9-502)
