

**MOAB CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
SPECIAL MEETING
November 12, 2025**

Special Meeting Attendance:

Moab City Council held a Special Meeting on the above date in Council Chambers. Archived audio is at www.utah.gov/pmn and video is at www.youtube.com/watch?v=8LGRyn1d4h8. Mayor Joette Langianese called the meeting to order at 5:46 p.m. for the purpose of canvassing the results of the 2025 General Municipal Election. Councilmembers Kaitlin Myers, Jason Taylor, Colin Topper, Luke Wojciechowski and Tawny Knuteson-Boyd attended. Also in attendance were City Manager Michael Black, Recorder Sommar Johnson, Police Chief Lex Bell, and one member of the public.

Canvass of the 2025 Municipal General Election:

Mayor Langianese stated the Council would consider certification of the election results with the City Council serving as the Board of Canvassers, and stated there was a high turnout with approximately 75 percent voter turnout.

Motion and Vote: Councilmember Knuteson-Boyd moved to accept the certification of the 2025 general municipal election results, held on November 4, 2025, declaring Joette Langianese, with a total of 1,194 votes, elected to the office of Mayor, and Miles Loftin, with a total of 1,155 votes, and Jason Taylor, with a total of 1,460 votes, elected to the office of City Council. Councilmember Wojciechowski seconded the motion. The motion passed 5-0 with Councilmembers Taylor, Knuteson-Boyd, Topper, Myers and Wojciechowski voting aye.
