

COMMISSION WORKSESSION

November 24, 2025

Minutes of a scheduled worksession of the Sevier County Commission held this tenth day of November 2025. Meeting commenced at 10:30 a.m. with Commissioners Scott Johnson, Greg Jensen, and Ralph Brown in the Conference Room, Room 116, of the Sevier County Administration Building, 250 North Main, Richfield, Utah. Clerk/Auditor Steven Wall , Tourism Director Amy Myers, and Executive Director Malcolm Nash were also present.

Mario Gonzales met with the Commission concerning his request for some additional funding to help pay for the mural that was painted on his building on 100 N in Richfield. He said he had purchased the building, and runs the bicycle shop, and wanted to put something on the side for tourism. He had spoken with an artist, and received a quote to do the mural. He received a grant from Maverik Corp. as well as some additional funding to Richfield City. He got the artist to add a mountain bike rider and pheasant to promote the Richfield and Sevier Valley area. The Commissioners expressed their appreciation for him wanting to promote tourism and help the economy with his business, but felt that his request coming in after the mural was done did not allow them the opportunity to add a logo or have any input to the contents of the mural as the other sponsors had. They expressed concern that if there was a possibility of future murals in other areas, they would need to help there as well. The Commission said that because there was not an opportunity to add County sponsorship, they did not wish to contribute, but the final decision would come during the Commission meeting later in the day.

There being no further business to come before the Board, meeting adjourned at 10:51 a.m.
