

CLEARFIELD CITY ORDINANCE 2025-25

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2025 CLEARFIELD CITY GENERAL PLAN BY ADDING THE WATER ELEMENT

PREAMBLE: This Ordinance amends Clearfield City's General Plan by adding the Water Use and Preservation Plan as an element.

WHEREAS, in July 2025, Clearfield City adopted an updated General Plan; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the amendment was to include the Water Use and Preservation Plan as an element as required by Utah Code Annotated § 10-20-401 and § 73-10-32; and

WHEREAS, after a public hearing on the matter, the Clearfield City Planning Commission recommended the Clearfield City Council approve the amendment of the 2025 Clearfield City General Plan by adding the Water Use and Preservation Plan as an element; and

WHEREAS, the Clearfield City Council received and reviewed the recommendation of the Clearfield City Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, following proper notice, as set forth by State Law, the City Council held a public hearing on the matter and received input thereon; and

WHEREAS, after the public hearing, the City Council carefully considered any comments made during the public hearing as well as the Planning Commission's recommendations regarding the proposed amendment to the 2025 Clearfield City General Plan; and

WHEREAS, following its public deliberation, the City Council has determined that the proposed amendment to the 2025 General Plan meets the needs of the City in the above mentioned areas;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Clearfield City Council that:

Section 1. Amendment to the 2025 Clearfield City General Plan: The Water Use and Preservation Plan is hereby approved as an element in the 2025 Clearfield City General Plan.

Section 2. Effective Date: This Ordinance shall become effective only upon its posting in three public places within Clearfield City.
