A RESOLUTION APPROVING LOGAN CITY'S WITHDRAWAL FROM THE LOGAN-CACHE AIRPORT AUTHORITY

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOGAN, UTAH THAT:

WHEREAS, the City of Logan and Cache County entered into an Agreement dated May 16, 1978 whereby the City conveyed certain real property to be used for the operation of the Logan-Cache Airport ("Airport") and the County agreed to assume responsibility for the maintenance and operation of the Airport;

WHEREAS, on December 1, 1992, the Parties entered an Interlocal Agreement that created the Logan-Cache Airport Authority ("Airport Authority") as a separate legal entity and set forth the terms governing the Parties' joint development, operation and maintenance of the Airport;

WHEREAS, the Parties have determined that the County is best positioned to continue the management, maintenance and operation of the Airport and it is in Parties' mutual best interests for the City to withdraw from the Airport Authority;

WHEREAS, the 1992 Agreement sets forth the conditions under which a Party may withdraw from the Airport Authority, including the right of a Party to withdraw with, or without, cause;

WHEREAS, the 1992 Agreement requires the legislative body of the Party desiring to withdraw from the Airport Authority to pass a resolution authorizing the withdrawal;

WHEREAS, the Parties desire that this Resolution authorize the City's withdrawal from the Airport Authority.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Logan Municipal Council that the attached resolution is hereby adopted and shall be in effect as of the date of the passage of this resolution.
