1. Accept and approve the results of the Municipal General Election held in South Salt Lake, Utah on November 4, 2025. City Recorder, Ariel Andrus, reviewed the election results from Salt Lake County with the Board of Canvassers.

Overall, there was a 33.3% voter turnout from the 9,948 active voters in the City. A total of 3,317 total ballots were counted.

The results of the 2025 Municipal General Election were as follows:
