- 4. <u>Approve minutes of October 8, 2025, Regular Meeting</u>: Marge Cipkar moved to approve the minutes of the October 8, 2025, Regular Town Board Meeting as presented. Travis Isaacson seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.
- 5. <u>Set public meeting date to canvass the 2025 Municipal General Election results</u>: Todd Robinson moved to meet on November 18, 2025, at 7:00 p.m. at the Paragonah Town Hall to Canvass the 2025 Municipal General Election results.

- 9. <u>Power/Fire Department Reports</u>: Travis Isaacson suggested the Town sponsor a Christmas Lighting incentive program like Parowan does. People who put up two or more strings of lights can sign up for a 10% discount on their December utility bill. They would have to be current on their bill, have them turned on by December 1st, and turn them on each night during the holiday season. Todd Robinson moved to approve sponsoring a Christmas Lighting Incentive Program this year as discussed and give people who sign up a 10% discount on their December utility bill. Travis Isaacson seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

Discussion took place concerning Chris Meneley wanting his temporary power connected. He is also waiting for the ordinance concerning building heights to be changed to 35 feet. For now he is putting up a 10 x 10 building so he can get power. His building plans have not yet been completed. Dan Burgett will hook up his water.
