If approved, this increase would bring in an additional 25 \$86,200 for operational costs. He explained the need was driven by inflationary pressures. including notable increases in utilities, insurance, and chlorine costs. For a median-valued home 26 27 of \$623,000, the impact would be about \$2.11 per year. 28 29 Council members thanked Councilmember Summerhays for his stewardship as he 30 outlined broader financial efforts by the district, including cutting non-viable programs, reducing 31 board stipends, and working to balance fees with tax support. He also clarified misconceptions stemming from years of stagnant tax rates and discussed the long-term need for sustainability. 32 33 With no public comments offered, Councilmember Summerhays noted that the District's final 34 budget would be presented on December 15. 35 36 <u>ADJOURNMENT</u> 37 38 At 5:50 pm, Councilmember Hirst moved to adjourn the meeting.
