
NOTICE – SOUTH DAVIS RECREATION DISTRICT – PROPOSED TAX INCREASE

Councilmember Summerhays, representing Centerville on the South Davis Recreation District Board, provided notice that the District is going through the Truth-In-Taxation process and is proposing a 5% tax levy increase. If approved, this increase would bring in an additional \$86,200 for operational costs. He explained the need was driven by inflationary pressures, including notable increases in utilities, insurance, and chlorine costs. For a median-valued home of \$623,000, the impact would be about \$2.11 per year.

Council members thanked Councilmember Summerhays for his stewardship as he outlined broader financial efforts by the district, including cutting non-viable programs, reducing board stipends, and working to balance fees with tax support. He also clarified misconceptions stemming from years of stagnant tax rates and discussed the long-term need for sustainability. With no public comments offered, Councilmember Summerhays noted that the District's final budget would be presented on December 15.

ADJOURNMENT

At 5:50 pm, Councilmember Hirst **moved** to adjourn the meeting. Councilmember Summerhays seconded the motion which passed unanimously (5-0).
