1. Welcome and Opening Remarks

Vice Chair Trina Limpert called the meeting to order at **8:05 a.m. MST** and noted the meeting was being recorded. She formally excused Chair Savage and President Tuminez and acknowledged Brian Murphy and Jared Finch were joining the meeting via TEAMS. Trina welcomed new board member Roger Connors and asked him to take a few minutes to introduce himself.

2. Resolutions of Appreciation

Directors Shauna Smith and Rob Gardner were recognized for their years of service on the Foundation Board. Kyle Reyes and Julie Anderson read aloud the Resolutions of Appreciation and presented them with gifts to thank them for their service. The Resolutions of Appreciation are attached to the end of the minutes.

3. Committee Reports

• Audit & Finance Committee

Director Rob Gardner confirmed that all financial matters are in order.

Governance Committee

Director Brian Epperson welcomed Roger Connors. He then encouraged board members to identify potential candidates for board membership.

• Investment Committee

Liz Sowards reported for the Investment Committee, highlighting endowment growth to \$129.7M, up from \$109M the prior year, with strong returns.

5. President's Message

CEO Kyle Reyes presented on behalf of President Tuminez, expressing appreciation for the board's strength and contributions. He shared updates on new trustees and academic leadership appointments, including recent hires in key colleges.

Reyes highlighted strategic initiatives such as the Applied AI Institute and programs designed to enhance student success and community engagement. He emphasized UVU's commitment to innovation, applied learning, and maintaining momentum as the university continues to grow and serve nearly 50,000 students.

6. Executive Closed Session

7. Session Reopened - Vice Chair Trina Limpert reconvened the open session meeting.

Guests were invited to return.

8. Evergreen Campaign Report

CEO Kyle Reyes provided a detailed update on the EverGREEN Campaign, noting that the campaign goal of \$250M has been surpassed, with the current total at \$249M and projected to exceed \$252M by December 31, 2025.

He highlighted major gifts, including \$35M from Rich and Marla Linder for the Xenter Health Professions Building and Orrin Hatch National Security Studies Center, and a \$5.2M gift for the Applied AI Institute. Kyle also reported the Scholarship Ball raised \$1.38M and shared the impact of the campaign, including 187 new scholarships and support for over 6,000 students.

He concluded by outlining upcoming celebration events in 2026, including State of the University on January 14, the Smith Engineering Building Ribbon Cutting on January 22, and UVU Day on the Hill on February 23.

9. Big Ideas Discussion

Director Vanessa Sloan proposed creating a UVU Advisory Council modeled after BYU's NAC to enhance student engagement and recurring giving.

Director Robbie Bastian suggested live-to-picture performances at the Noorda Center to increase community and student engagement in the arts.

Both ideas were noted for further discussion and development.

10. Legislative Update

Steve Anderson, Associate Vice President of University Relations at UVU provided an overview of UVU's legislative priorities and advocacy efforts. He discussed plans for federal funding for the Utah Lake Research & Nature Center, which would support environmental research and education initiatives. He also outlined the Olympic Workforce 2034 initiative, aimed at preparing Utah's workforce for the 2034 Winter Olympics through programs such as hospitality management.

Additionally, he shared the strategy for securing funding for the Health Professions Building at Vineyard and emphasized the importance of legislative engagement. Board members were invited to participate in advocacy efforts and attend UVU Day on the Hill on February 23, 2026.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:10 a.m. MST.
