Discussion and Action Items

Danes Park – Tami Jeppesen

Tami Jeppesen provided updates on Danes Park, outlining plans to complete improvements with the assistance of volunteers and available funds. She reviewed the rock wall project, which was approved with a bid of \$8,000 from Heavy Iron to enhance the park's stability. Additionally, she mentioned the need for turf installation, with estimates around \$7,500, contingent upon assistance from the town's workers. To prevent future overspending, communication challenges in project management and oversight were also discussed. **Public Works Director Marcus Abel** will oversee all park projects. **Tami** highlighted the positive community response to the recent improvements, noting that families are increasingly using the space, reflecting the community's commitment to creating a vibrant environment.

Jared Jeppsen made a motion to approve up to \$28,000.00 to finish the items on the list presented to us today, excluding the fence and rock wall. **Ken Jones** seconded.

Youth Council Director

Jared Jeppsen addressed the council regarding the Mantua Youth Council director position, sharing that **Lindsay Strong** has approached **Karen Nelson** with a proposal to revive the youth council, which had not gained traction in previous years. He mentioned that she has developed a code of conduct, an application process, and a schedule for recruitment. The council discussed the eligibility for the council, which is set for grades 7 to 12.

Jared Jeppsen made a motion to appoint Lindsay Strong as the Youth Council Director for the Mantua Youth

Ordinances - Chief Dakota Midkiff

Police Chief Dakota Midkiff highlighted the need to update local ordinances, pointing out their lack of essential elements for effective enforcement. He proposed creating an ordinance review committee to ensure compliance and clarity in the laws. Additionally, **Dakota** noted that existing ordinances are often difficult for officers to access on the town's website. He emphasized the importance of collaboration between the police department, the council, and the judicial branch to enhance enforcement efforts.

Public Works Overview - Marcus Abel

Marcus Abel provided updates on various public works projects. He mentioned ongoing challenges in maintaining roads and infrastructure, estimating that significant repairs could cost up to \$1 million over the next decade. The Main Street project is set to begin in early spring, while issues with deteriorating water lines and the need for better communication within the department were highlighted. He emphasized the importance of regular employee meetings to improve teamwork and efficiency. Additionally, Marcus raised concerns about the need for proper safety equipment for sewer operations, as well as the necessity to replace outdated infrastructure to ensure public safety and compliance.
