- Floors, walls, and half the lid are complete.
- Scaffolding will remain until December 3, then move to complete the lid.
- Pump house expected to be completed by the end of 2025.

#### 11. Water Report

- Water usage: 84% of purchased water from Weber Basin, 77% from Ogden City.
- Bona Vista is at 98% of its water source.
- All wells are off; the last was turned off on October 31, 2025.

#### 12. Staff and Board comments

- Matt Fox: Expressed appreciation to all board members; clarified that the chairman serves a two-year term, and Chairman Stratford has one year remaining.
- Kenny Hefflefinger: Expressed gratitude for working with the board.
- Mayor Van Leeuwen: Clarified decision not to run for future term and expressed appreciation for serving and working with the board.
- **Mayor Beesley:** Praised collaboration with the elected board members; highlighted differences in new administration and appreciation for citizen-focused decisions.

- **Mayor Tait:** Provided update on a 1-acre parcel in Harrisville for a future well; City Manager is aware.
  - Matt Fox: Noted city engineers are interested in pursuing the well at that location.
- **Chris Crockett:** Extended holiday wishes and expressed gratitude for working with the board.
- Mayor Beesley: Asked for clarification on TIF/RDA for Farr West; noted denial by school district and others.
  - Mayor Tait: Clarified TIF/RDA not passed; suggested future agenda discussion.
  - o Chris Crockett: Will review packet before next meeting.
- Shauna Gilchrist: Expressed gratitude and clarified FY 2026 hearing processes.
- Chairman Stratford: Expressed pleasure in working with all mayors on the board.
