JOB Description

Cedar Mountain Fire Rescue Wildland is offering a seasonal full time position for a Senior Firefighter for the 2026 fire season. A qualified individual needs to possess a valid drivers license and meet NWCG requirements of Firefighter Type 1, Incident Commander Type 5, and Faller Type 3, (Faller Type 2 Preferred). Completed task books required. Candidates must be able to pass a background check and drug screen. The selected candidate will be available through the western fire season and may be available year round, on a **Call When Needed** basis. The candidate will serve as a Senior Firefighter on Type 3 and Type 6 engines responding to incidents locally and nationally, as well as perform fuels mitigation work as a member of a Fuels/Suppression Module. This position may also respond in a support capacity to **All Hazard Incidents** including structure and vehicle fires, traffic collisions, medical aid, search and rescue and other natural disasters. Daily physical and technical training will also be required when not assigned to an incident. The individual will maintain personal physical fitness and encourage others along with building and maintaining crew cohesion. **Preference will be given to seasons of experience, Faller Type 2 and NREMTB qualifications.**
