Result of legislative action

Background:

The Small District Capital Projects Fund was created during the 2022 General Session in House Bill 475, "Use of Public Education Stabilization Account One-time Funding." The program supports capital development (construction of new schools, additions, renovations) in small school districts. Capital project applications are reviewed by an advisory panel to the State Board of Education, which acts on recommendations of the panel. For FY26, the Legislature appropriated \$12.5 million to the fund.
