



Currently serving as Battalion Chief with the North Summit Fire District, Tyler has built a career grounded in emergency response, fire-service operations, and community-driven governance.

In addition to his fire-service role, Tyler has served multiple terms on the Coalville City Council. Through that local-government experience he's become conversant with municipal budgeting, growth-management, ordinance review and infrastructure planning.

Tyler's interest in the UCA Public Safety Advisory Committee is driven by his commitment to ensuring that Utah's first-responder communications systems are robust, interoperable and responsive to the needs of both urban and rural agencies. He sees this committee as a critical forum through which system-wide policies, network strategy and infrastructure decisions can be influenced by practitioners in the field aligned with community needs. The statutory charge of the committee—advising on operations, maintenance, capital development and access to the statewide public-safety communications network—is well suited to his combined experience in emergency operations and municipal governance.

Tyler is prepared to leverage his frontline fire-service perspective, his municipal policy experience and his deep familiarity with the realities of rural Utah to contribute meaningfully to the committee's deliberations. By joining the committee, he aims to strengthen the voice of smaller jurisdictions, help bridge the gap between equipment/technology decisions and operational realities, and support the UCA in fostering communications networks that genuinely enable mission-critical response across the state.
