Thank you to each of you for convening to review the CUP application for demolition of the Historic Old Mill.

As you prepare for your forthcoming meeting, I respectfully ask that the Planning Commission address why Cottonwood Heights Municipal Code §19.86.045, *Protective Maintenance Required*, is not being considered as part of your evaluation of this application.

Section 19.86.045 clearly establishes that owners of designated historic sites have an affirmative obligation to maintain and repair those structures so they are not destroyed by neglect, weather, vandalism, or deterioration. The ordinance further provides the City with the authority to investigate the condition of historic sites, identify specific deficiencies, notify the property owner, and require corrective action within a defined timeframe prior to a structure becoming so deteriorated that preservation is no longer possible.

Given these requirements, it is important for the Commission to consider whether demolition is being proposed as a result of long-term neglect that may fall within the scope of this ordinance, and whether the protective maintenance provisions have been fully applied and enforced.

Is it appropriate to recommend a full audit?

I appreciate your careful attention to this matter and your continued service to the City in safeguarding both our planning process and our historic resources.



On behalf of Preservation Utah, we submit this public comment regarding the request for a Conditional Use Permit (CUP-25-005) that would allow demolition of the Cottonwood Paper Mill, also known as the Old Mill, located at 6851 South Big Cottonwood Canyon Road.

The Cottonwood Paper Mill is a rare and irreplaceable historic resource with deep significance to Cottonwood Heights and the broader region. Constructed in the early 1880s, the mill represents one of Utah's earliest industrial enterprises and remains one of the last surviving physical reminders of early industrial development along Big Cottonwood Canyon. Its stone construction, setting, and continued visibility make it a defining landmark in the area.

Beyond its architectural and historical importance, the Old Mill holds profound community and place-based significance. Over time, it has become a widely recognized reference point and identity anchor for the surrounding area. This is evident not only in public advocacy and community engagement, but also in the way nearby development has adopted the “Old Mill” name—used extensively in office buildings, commercial centers, and neighborhood branding. Community members have already expressed strong concern about the proposed demolition through public outreach, advocacy efforts, and formal petitions. These concerns consistently emphasize that while growth and reinvestment are expected, the complete loss of this landmark would sever a tangible connection to local history and undermine the distinct character that draws people to this area. The Old Mill is not simply an unused structure; it is a symbol that continues to define place, memory, and continuity for residents and visitors alike.

Demolition would result in the permanent loss of a historic resource that cannot be replaced. Once removed, the physical evidence of this chapter of Cottonwood Heights' history would be gone, leaving only its name behind—a reminder of what was lost rather than what was stewarded forward.

Preservation Utah recognizes the complexities of redevelopment and supports thoughtful planning that balances growth with stewardship. Across Utah and the nation, historic industrial sites similar to the Cottonwood Paper Mill have been successfully stabilized and adaptively reused, contributing to economic vitality while preserving community character. We strongly encourage consideration of alternatives to demolition, including adaptive reuse, partial preservation, or further study that meaningfully engages preservation professionals and community stakeholders.

We respectfully urge the Planning Commission to:

- Give full consideration to the historic, cultural, and community significance of the Cottonwood Paper Mill.
- Weigh the cumulative public concern already expressed regarding its loss.
- Encourage preservation-minded alternatives that retain this landmark as part of Cottonwood Heights' future.

The Old Mill's continued presence matters—not only for what it represents historically, but for how it continues to shape identity, sense of place, and community pride today. We appreciate the Commission's thoughtful review and commitment to public process.

My name is Ronnie Pessetto, and I am the Executive Director of Seven Canyons Trust, a nonprofit organization dedicated to uncovering and restoring the seven creeks of the Salt Lake Valley, including Big Cottonwood Creek and Little Cottonwood Creek. Our work focuses on protecting water quality, restoring riparian ecosystems, and helping communities plan development in ways that recognize waterways as essential natural infrastructure.

I am writing to express concern regarding the proposed demolition of the Old Mill building and to advocate for a more thoughtful approach to development that prioritizes both historic preservation and the long-term health of the adjacent creek.

The Old Mill is an important cultural and historical resource within the canyon. Its demolition would represent a permanent loss to the community's sense of place and history. Preservation and adaptive reuse should be meaningfully explored as part of this process, particularly given the site's close relationship to the creek and the surrounding landscape.

In addition, the creek adjacent to this development is far more than an aesthetic feature. Creeks provide critical ecological services, including stormwater conveyance, water filtration, habitat connectivity, temperature regulation, and flood resilience. Poorly designed development near waterways can lead to increased erosion, degraded water quality, higher water temperatures, and long-term maintenance burdens for both the city and downstream communities.

This site also presents a meaningful opportunity to restore the creek in a way that improves both ecological function and public benefit. With thoughtful design, the creek corridor could become more accessible to adjacent residents, support safe and appropriate community access, and promote greater neighborhood and environmental connectivity within Cottonwood Heights. When designed well, creek restoration can strengthen community identity while improving environmental outcomes.

This project presents an opportunity to do better. We encourage the Planning Commission to require development approaches that meaningfully protect and enhance the creek, including but not limited to:

- Adequate setbacks and riparian buffers
- Design strategies that reduce runoff, erosion, and pollutant loading
- Restoration or enhancement of native riparian vegetation
- Improved, context-sensitive access to the creek for nearby residents
- Long-term stewardship considerations that recognize the creek as vital infrastructure

Seven Canyons Trust supports development that is context-sensitive, historically informed, and environmentally responsible. Preserving the Old Mill and designing around the creek in a way that improves its condition and community connectivity would demonstrate leadership and a commitment to long-term environmental and community health.

To the Cottonwood Heights Planning Commission.

This is Dr. John Newman. I am a resident of Sandy rather than Cottonwood Heights. However, my family homesteaded at the south end of Holladay Boulevard, not far from the Cottonwood Paper Mill, aka the "Old Mill."

I am disappointed by the shortsightedness of the developer and the planning commission in considering the demolition of the landmark historical structure, and I hope that more reasonable voices will prevail. I understand that the structure would require a major investment that might come a mix of public and private sources. It would be civically responsible of the land owner, who will profit from development of adjacent properties, to invest in the restoration of the Old Mill.

The Old Mill is perhaps the only iconic historical structure in the boundaries of Cottonwood Heights and therefore the city has one opportunity and obligation to do the right thing in preserving its heritage, whereas other cities with more historic structures have numerous opportunities. A historic structure like the Old Mill ties a modern bedroom community to its historic roots and it is critical to the aesthetic landscape. Park City lost its historic Mining Coalition building to fire in the 1970s and developers have since built multiple replicas to fill that hole. Salt Lake City tore down both the Salt Lake Theatre and the Social Hall from the pioneer era, and each of the structures has not only one replica but two. Does it not make sense to preserve a defining architectural feature rather than erase it from memory or try replicate it after it has been demolished?

Holladay City took the opportunity to restore Holladay School as its City Hall, which makes Holladay feel like a city rather than a suburb without a nucleus. Cottonwood Heights has an attractive and functional city hall on Bengal Boulevard, but the city needs a structure like the Old Mill to give the community a sense of heritage.

Please take the long view, prohibit the demolition of the structure, and work with the developer and historical agencies to preserve the Cottonwood Paper Mill. Let it become the legacy of the current planning commission and city council. Heed the pleadings of more than a thousand citizens who have signed a petition to preserve the historic structure and help it to become Cottonwood Height's defining icon.

Cottonwood Heights Planning Commission,

As you review the request for a conditional use permit to demolish the Old Mill building, please carefully consider the conditional use standards in section 19.84.080.B, specifically #14:

- **That the proposed use preserves historical, architectural... features of the property;**

If the request does not meet this standard, then you must either deny the project or add conditions to ensure compliance (or table the item to allow extra time to demonstrate compliance). This is partially assessed using the expert information provided in the staff report, but should also be informed by comments received from the public.

In my opinion, **this CUP does not comply with the standards of approval because it does not preserve any historical or architectural features.** Even if some historical building *materials* are reused on another project or if a plaque is erected to commemorate the site, no actual historical *features* are being preserved. A plain reading of the code states that historical *features* must be preserved.

The engineers' evaluations seem to indicate that a full restoration of the site would be cost-prohibitive, which I'm sure is true (even though cost isn't relevant to the conditional use standards). What's missing from the reports is a robust evaluation of any other significant preservation options. Historic preservation is more than a simple yes or no choice to demolish - there are many other options that should be evaluated before making your decision, including:

- **Partial Preservation/Restoration**
 - While it may not be possible to save the whole building, it still might be possible to save part. The Planning Commission could consider approving the demolition of only a portion of the building, with a condition to preserve a notable feature.
 - It might be worth evaluating which prominent building features could be saved. Would it be possible to save the tower? Could any of the walls be saved and used as a facade on a future building? Would it be possible to preserve the old broken wall as some sort of entry feature for the new subdivision?
- **Full or Partial Relocation**
 - Yes, it's possible to move buildings! So it may be possible to move the Old Mill to another location. It could potentially be moved to another location on the development site or even moved to a completely new location.
 - While this is a complicated, technical process, it would cost significantly less than a full restoration. At this point, it's hard for the Planning Commission to evaluate the feasibility of this option, since no study or evaluation has been provided for your review. This would be the ideal solution in my opinion.

- **Full or Partial Reconstruction**

- Reconstructing the building in another location is essentially another type of relocation. This option would involve carefully disassembling and reassembling the building (or an important feature of the building) in another location. If a full relocation isn't possible, I don't see any reason why this option wouldn't work. This option should be considered if a full relocation isn't possible.

I hope that the Commission will consider adding one of the above options as a condition of approval for this request. The Old Mill is truly the only notable or interesting building left in the entire city!

I am responding to the call for commentary on the pending council meeting regarding the fate of the historic Cottonwood Paper Mill. While I am not a Cottonwood Heights resident, I am a near-by Sandy resident and I have thought a lot about what the Paper Mill could become if it were to be restored. I wanted to touch base in respect to possible landscaping here if it becomes a venue or something similar. I am the Manager for the Pollinator Habitat Program with the state Department of Agriculture and Food. I am able to grow out native flowing perennials and shrubs for low-to-no cost depending on the species in large bulk quantities and I would personally love to see this space beautifully landscaped in native flowers and habitat. I would also professionally relish the opportunity to see this become a great partnership example of state funded/supplemented incentives for local municipalities to create water wise, native, eco-friendly landscaping and would be happy to discuss this opportunity with city planners and officials. It could additionally be highlighted or partnered with other organizations like Utah Water Ways and Jordan Valley Water Conservation District if this was of interest to the City moving forward.

Lastly, I wanted to plug in the example here that Wheeler Historic Farm is a county-funded wedding/rental venue that generates thousands of dollars in rental fees each year that the county is able to invest back into their general fund. The City of Cottonwood Heights could greatly benefit from an investment into a similar venue, and could use the already-established County model for rental facilities and transactions while likely charging a much higher premium because it would be a newer, sought after venue. Landscaping the grounds to be a publicly available, natively restored, pollinator focused, walking trail/garden demonstration destination would be a bonus to local residents through maintaining open public spaces and showcasing the city's commitment to native wildlife and waterwise conservation efforts.

My name is Deborah Bush and I served on the Cottonwood Heights Committee for Restoring The Historic Old Mill.

In 2019, the plans for The Cottonwood Heights Community Center for The Arts were all in place, complete with architectural renderings and site development plans. Multiple professionals in the community were on-board to donate time and materials, at their own expense. Hundreds of emails were sent! Dozens of meetings were held. An outstanding development company had spent months assessing the possibilities for the project. In about 2019, an equitable offer was presented to the owners, that was both fair and reasonable.

At first the owners seemed very interested! But as time went on, there was always a new reason – something they needed to check out before they could accept the offer. In 2020, it became more difficult to contact them due to covid, but everyone was still hopeful in 2021.

So many members of the community were sitting in anticipation of the beautiful Cottonwood Heights Community Center for the Arts, set along the Historic Trail to the city's Old Mill Park, in beautiful Cottonwood Creek Canyon! Dedicated citizens expertise had gone into the plans to convert The Old Mill to a wonderful asset for Cottonwood Heights! Mayor Peterson and his City Council, were optimistic & excited about the project. All were waiting! Waiting for a simple 'Yes/No' reply from the property owners. The reply never came! By 2022 it became obvious that other plans were being made for the Old Mill and its surrounding acreage.

Fast forward 5 years. A building that was declared stable by our committee's structural engineer is now in a state of deterioration with windows out, and a leaking roof.

A member of The Old Mill Restoration Committee texted the following: "It is devastating (to think that The Old Mill may be) demolished! We brought the best offer, the best team, the best plan. And they would never move forward."

According to the requirements stated in City Code 15.15.030 & 040, an owner cannot demolish an historic building unless they can prove the the building is Unusable and Unsellable.

The truth is that the building is sellable and it is usable, and therefore under city code 15.15.040, it is not eligible for a CoA Certificate of Appropriateness because it does not meet the requirements for a Historic Building to be demolished:

Cottonwood Height City Code 15.15.040: Section B: '

1). The owners paid for a seismic certification to state that the building does not meet seismic standards, which is potentially biased or due to neglect. Others have found the building to be stable:

- In about 2018, the building was assessed by our committee's structural engineer who found the building to be in stable condition, as per the request of the developer at the time.

- If the Old Mill could have become Hale Center Theatre, as was in the plans, it would certainly have been considered viable economically.

2). The Old Mill's greatest asset is its aesthetic! For that alone it is serving a beneficial use! It most assuredly would have been a wonderful asset to the city of Cottonwood Heights to have had a Community Center for the Arts. Another idea has also come to the forefront, as many citizens view it as beautiful structure, worth preserving even as a ruin like the ruins of Rome. Salt Lake Parks and Rec stand ready to assist in finding funding if the city would like to move forward with making it an extension of the current Old Mill Park & walking path along the river.

3). The owners to my knowledge have never declined the offer they received. We never left the bargaining table – they did. When we receive a clear answer, then they will officially have refused to sell.

4). The building is falling into ruin due to failure to maintain the historic structure, thru neglect and the owners should be held accountable. Previous administrations have given the owners a pass, since they thought the Old Mill was about to be rehabilitated.

However when the owners contacted the city in 2024 about their desire to build apartments and demolish the Old Mill, rather than require owners to follow city code & maintain the building, the Mayor and the recently appointed City Council liaison to the Historic Committee (who was appointed by the mayor to replace long-time dedicated Historic Committee liaison Ellen Birrell in Jan 2024), met privately with the owners, and gave them a pass on maintaining the building and further stated that 'the city had no interest in preserving The Old Mill,' as was publicly stated by the owners at the July Historic Committee meeting, much to the dismay of all the long-time Historic Committee members, who had not been consulted.

When the owners appeal for early demolition failed, State Representative Gay Lynn Bennion and I met with the mayor, in an effort to look for solutions to save the Old Mill. I still feel strongly that the majority of the would support rehabilitating the Old Mill. Mayor Weichers suggested a survey be conducted. This is a great idea! I hope the Planning Commission and the City Council will take the initiative to conduct a survey of public sentiment prior to making their decision!

Interestingly, the former 15.15.030 & 40 prior to changes enacted by the May 2024 Ordinance No. 416, included the following criteria for demolition of a historic building:

- The demolition should not negatively affect the district's character or concentration of historic resources.
- The site should show no willful neglect.
- The approval of The Historic Preservation Committee is required
