

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-____

**AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE COMPENSATION OF
ELECTIVE AND STATUTORY OFFICERS**

WHEREAS, Utah law 10-3-818 provides that elective and statutory officers in municipalities may only receive compensation for services pursuant to ordinance enacted by the legislative body following a public hearing;

WHEREAS, the elected and statutory officials of the city include the Mayor, Councilmembers, City Attorney, City Recorder, Treasurer, Police Chief, City Engineer and Planning Commissioners, and the Mayor, Councilmembers, and Planning Commission already have compensation described by ordinance;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Kamas, Utah that:

Section I: The annual compensation for elective and statutory officials is as follows, in addition to those found in Kamas City Code Section 2.02.010:

Police Chief – \$55.86
City Recorder – \$41.58
Treasurer – \$37.22

Section II: Effective Date. All wages paid at such rates prior to the adoption of this ordinance are hereby ratified and approved. This Ordinance shall become effective upon publication and posting as required by law.
