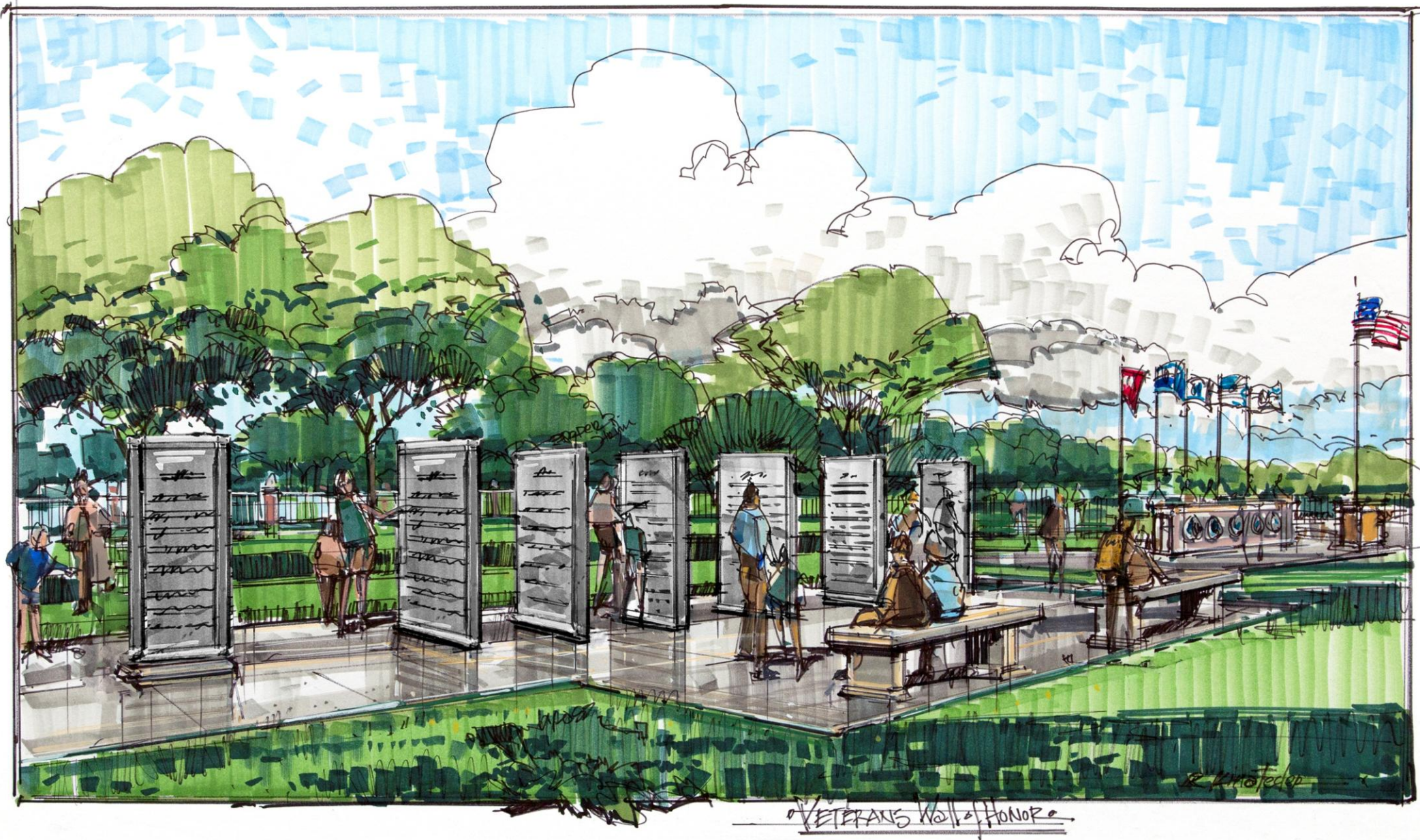
Veterans Wall of Honor

American Legion's Vision

- Recognize and honor all military veterans that have served and are now buried in the Springville Cemeteries.
- Also recognize other military veterans from Springville and Mapleton that served and are buried elsewhere.
- Include veterans from all Wars.
- Special recognition to those that were killed in action.

Plans for the Wall Installations

- Evergreen includes
 - Granite epitaphs: 5 for current names, 1 for future names and 1 for special recognition of Killed in Action (KIA)
 - Concrete walkways and 2 benches
- Springville City (Historic) includes:
 - Granite epitaph for current names and future names

Memorandum of Understanding

- American Legion Post 28 Will:
 - Bear the procurement and installation cost through donations.
 - Arrange for engraving updates and annual cleaning.
 - Collect and Validate all names to be listed on the Wall.
- Springville City Will:
 - Provide excavation for the installation.
 - Oversee contractor installation work.
 - Maintain grounds and prevent watering of the stones.

Future Maintenance

- Springville City
 - Grounds Maintenance
 - Prevent watering of Stones
- American Legion
 - Summarize New Names each year
 - Engraving of New Names
 - 30 per Year at \$14 each, \$420 per year
 - Annual Cleaning of Stones with volunteers
