







SUVPS PROPERTY ACQUISITION FOR TRAIL

The Parks & Recreation department has been approached by neighbors of the Dry Creek Trail to make improvements to the trail and adjacent city owned property. One of the issues of the trail is it currently has no destination. The Parks & Recreation staff observed that the nearby Kelvin Grove Park could be an easy destination for the trail if property along dry creek north of the SUVPS station could be acquired. SUVPS was contacted with the idea and subsequently agreed to quit claim the property to the city with an easement to maintain the fence along the north side of the station.
