NOTICE

A Notice of Intent for the following project submitted in accordance with R307-401-1, Utah Administrative Code (UAC), has been received for consideration by the Director:

Company Name: Granite Construction Company

Location: Granite Construction Company - I-80 South Quarry – Off Exit 132, Ranch Exit of Interstate I-80, East of Salt Lake City, Salt Lake County, UT

Project Description: The Granite Construction Company (GCC) has requested to operate an aggregate mining facility at its I-80 South Quarry in Salt Lake County. The facility will consist of aggregate mining, crushing, and screening operations. GCC will operate crushers, diesel generators, conveyors, a feeder, and a screen at this location. The facility will be a new minor source of PM, NO_x, CO, SO₂, VOCs, and HAPs. It will be located in an area designated as maintenance for PM_{2.5}, as well as nonattainment for ozone and SO₂.

The Director published the Intent to Issue an Approval Order for this project on December 17, 2025, initiating a 30-day public comment period. Within 15 days of the start of the public comment period, a request was submitted to extend the comment period. In accordance with UAC R307-401-7, the public comment period will be extended by an additional 15 days. Therefore, the public comment period will end on January 31, 2026.

Additionally, the Division of Air Quality will hold a public hearing for this project. The public hearing will be held from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, January 28, 2026, at Millcreek City Hall, located at 1330 East Chambers Ave., Millcreek, UT 84106. The hearing will take place in the Grandview Room on the sixth floor.

The completed engineering evaluation and air quality impact analysis showed the proposed project meets the requirements of federal air quality regulations and the State air quality rules. The Director intends to issue an Approval Order pending a 30-day public comment period. The project proposal, estimate of the effect on local air quality, and draft Approval Order are available for public inspection and comment at the Utah Division of Air Quality, 195 North 1950 West, Salt Lake City, UT 84116. Written comments received by the Division at this same address on or before January 31, 2026, will be considered in making the final decision on the approval/disapproval of the proposed project. Email comments will also be accepted at jpersons@utah.gov. If anyone so requests to the Director in writing within 15 days of publication of this notice, a hearing will be held in accordance with R307-401-7, UAC.

Under Section 19-1-301.5, a person who wishes to challenge a Permit Order may only raise an issue or argument during an adjudicatory proceeding that was raised during the public comment period and was supported with sufficient information or documentation to enable the Director to fully consider the substance and significance of the issue. **Date of Notice: January 14, 2026**
