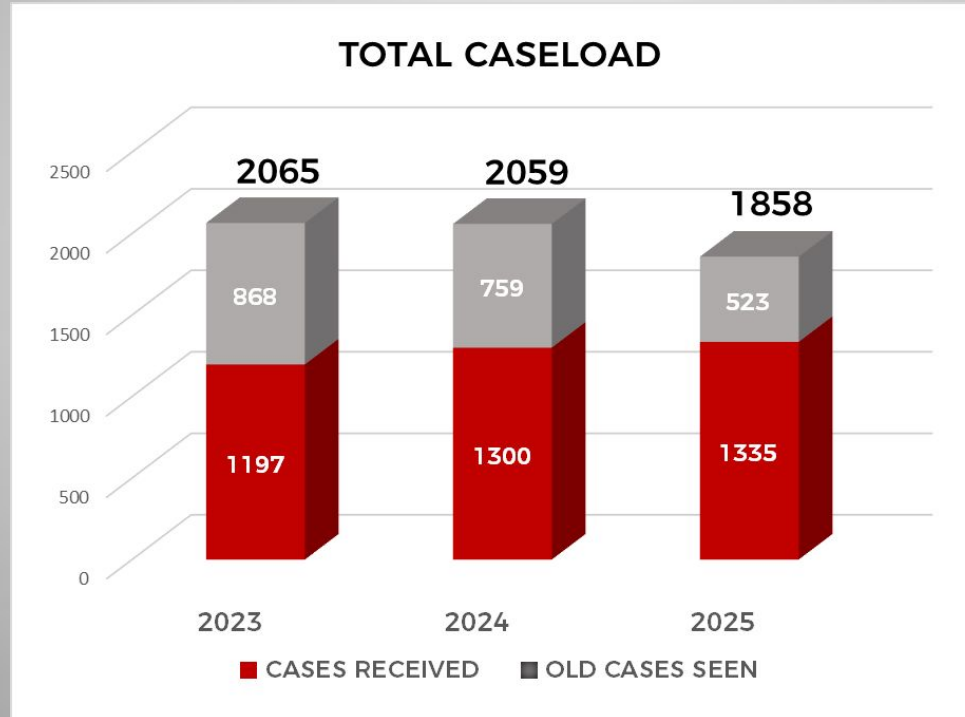

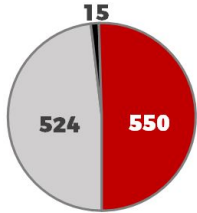

Cases Received in each Calendar Year

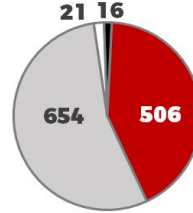
2022 Total Cases By Type - 1089 Cases

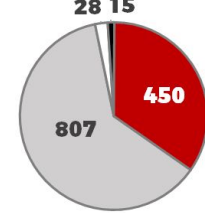
2023 Total Cases by Type - 1197 Cases

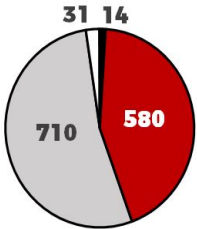
2024 Total Cases by Type - 1300 Cases

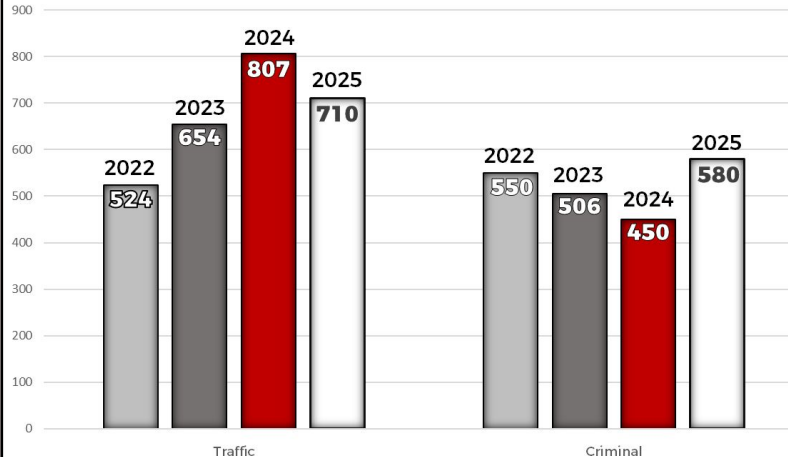


2025 Total Cases by Type - 1335 Cases

Factors Affecting Caseload

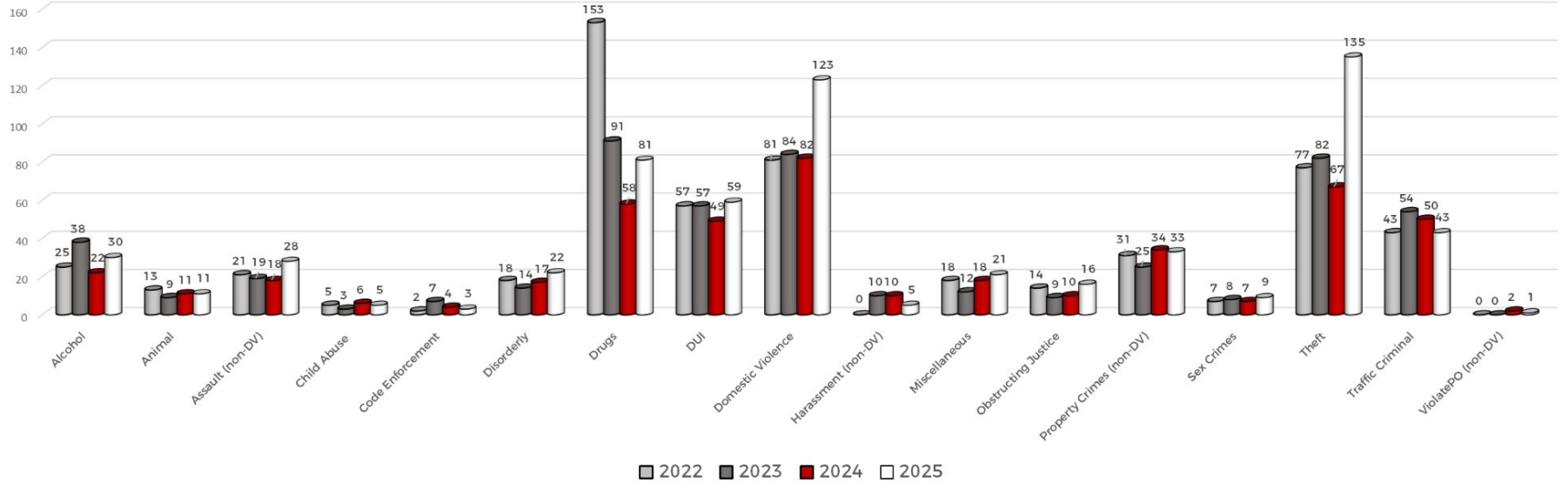
Local Factors

- Screening cases more closely

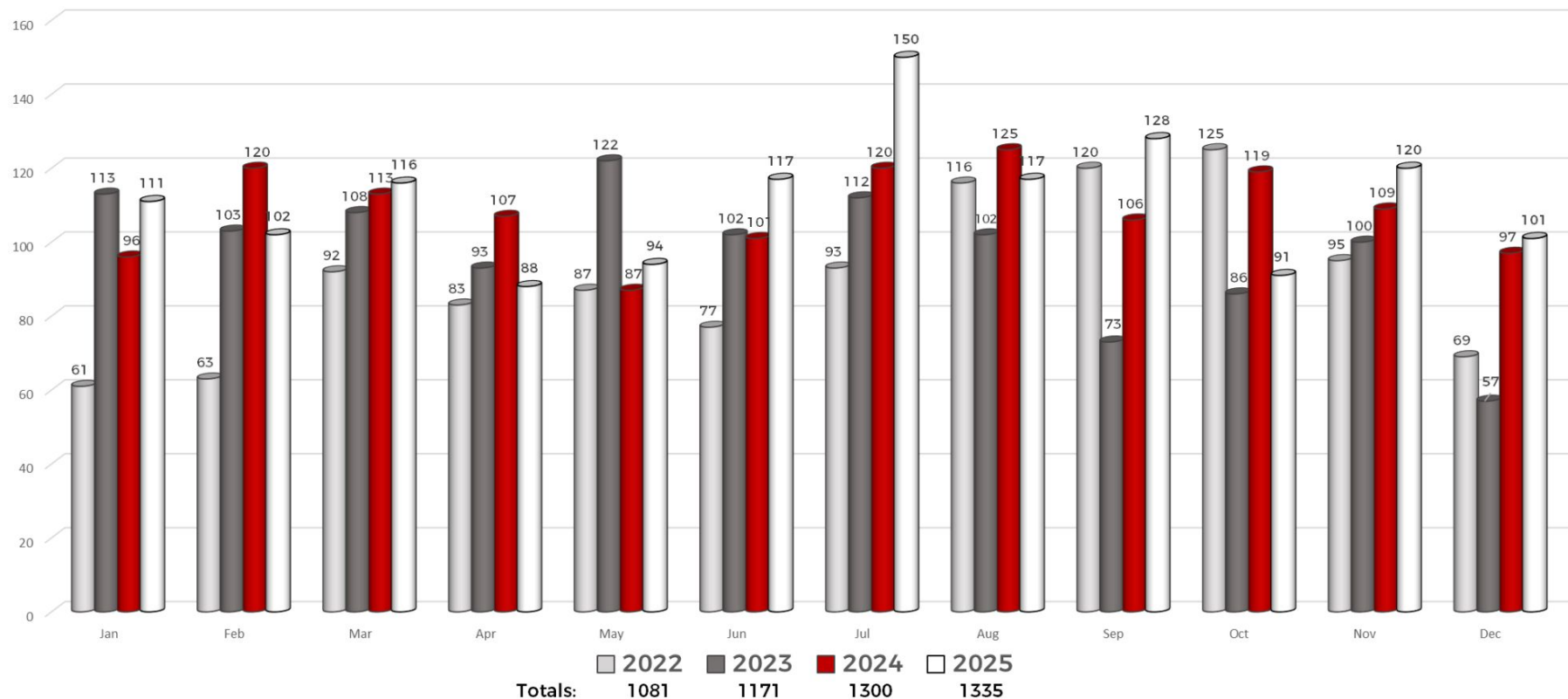
General Factors

- Density of population

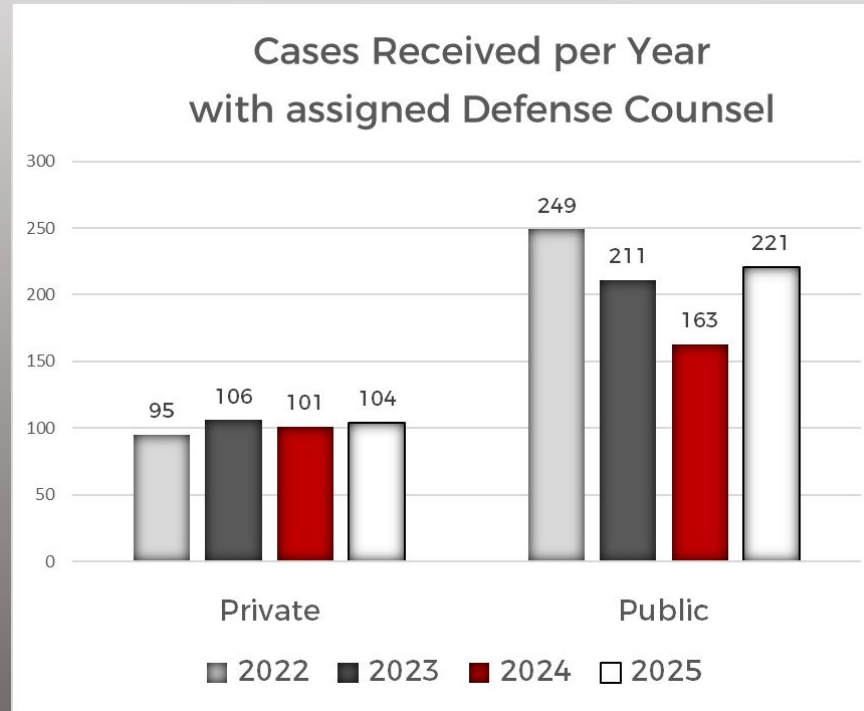
Criminal Categories by Year

Cases Received by Year That have Defense Counsel

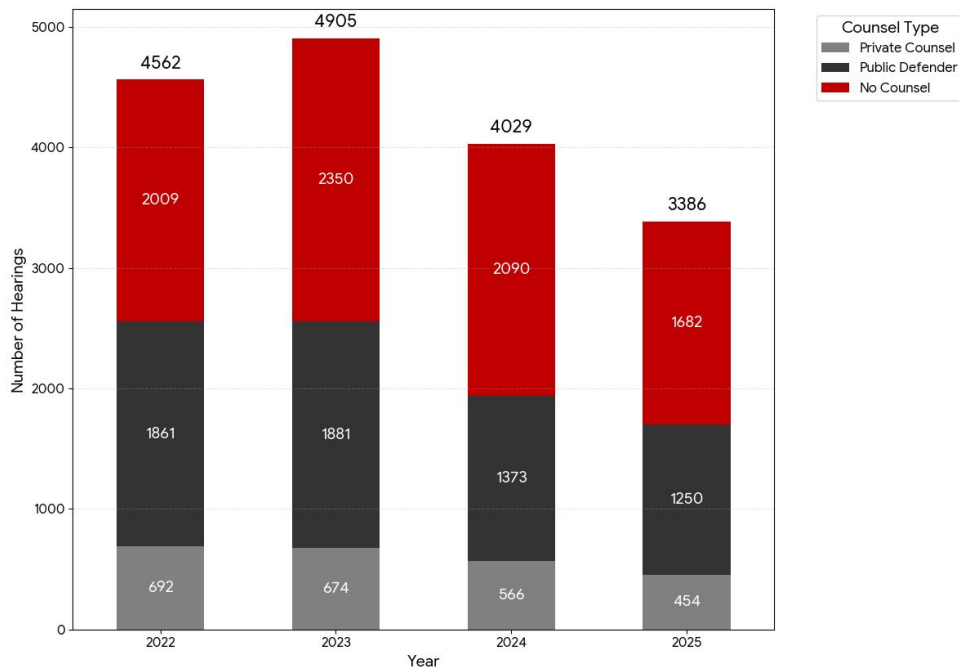


Total Hearings by Year with Defense Counsel

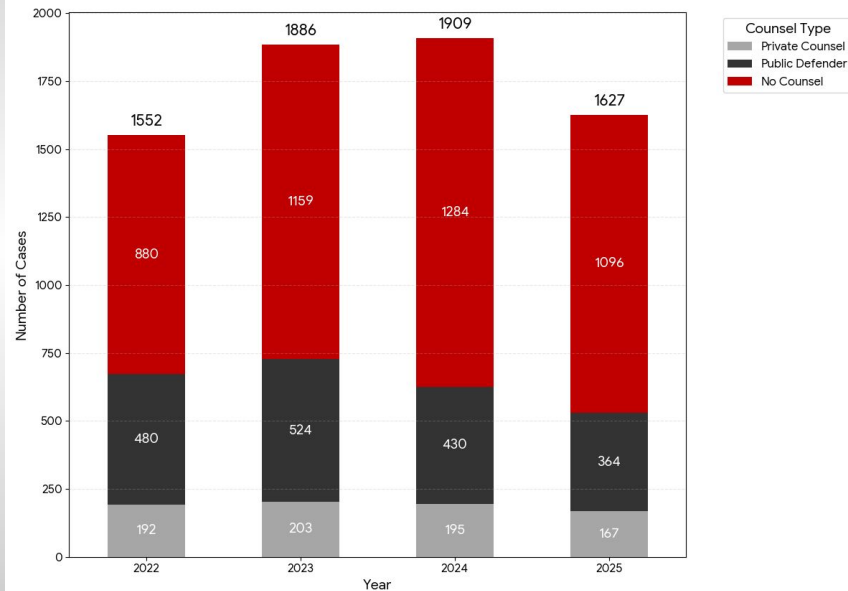

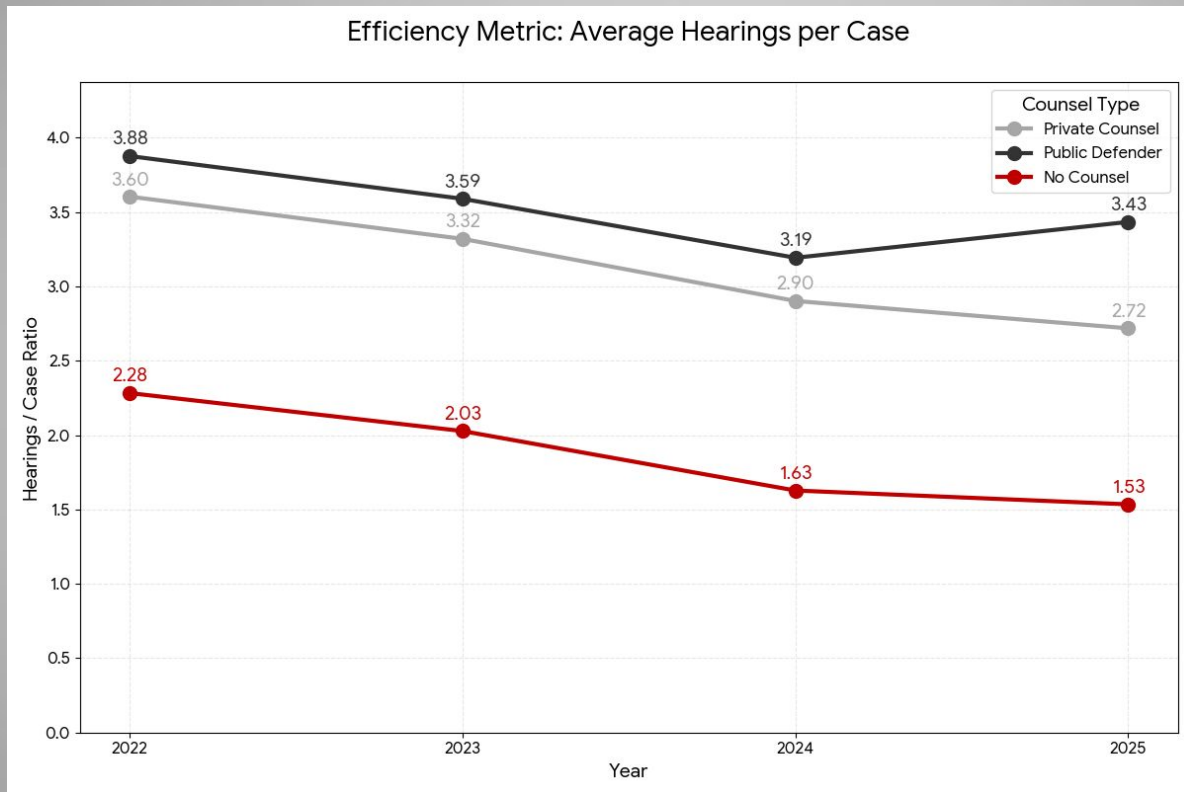
Hearings per Year by Defense Counsel Type



How many cases made up those hearings

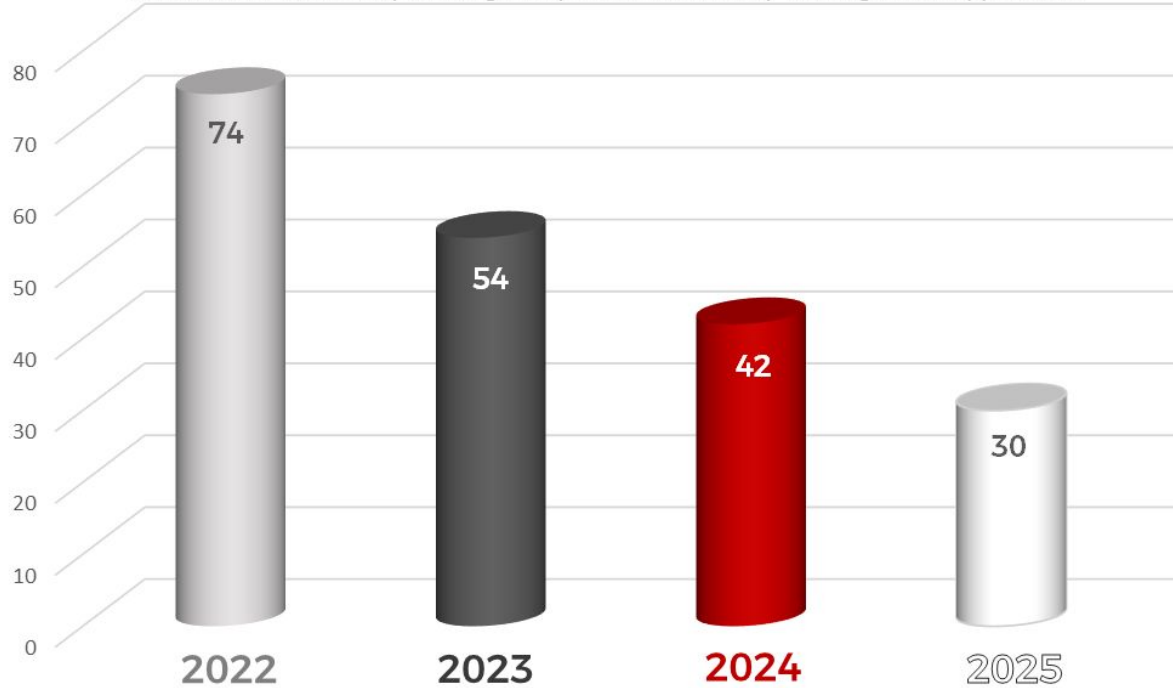


Average Hearings per Case by Year

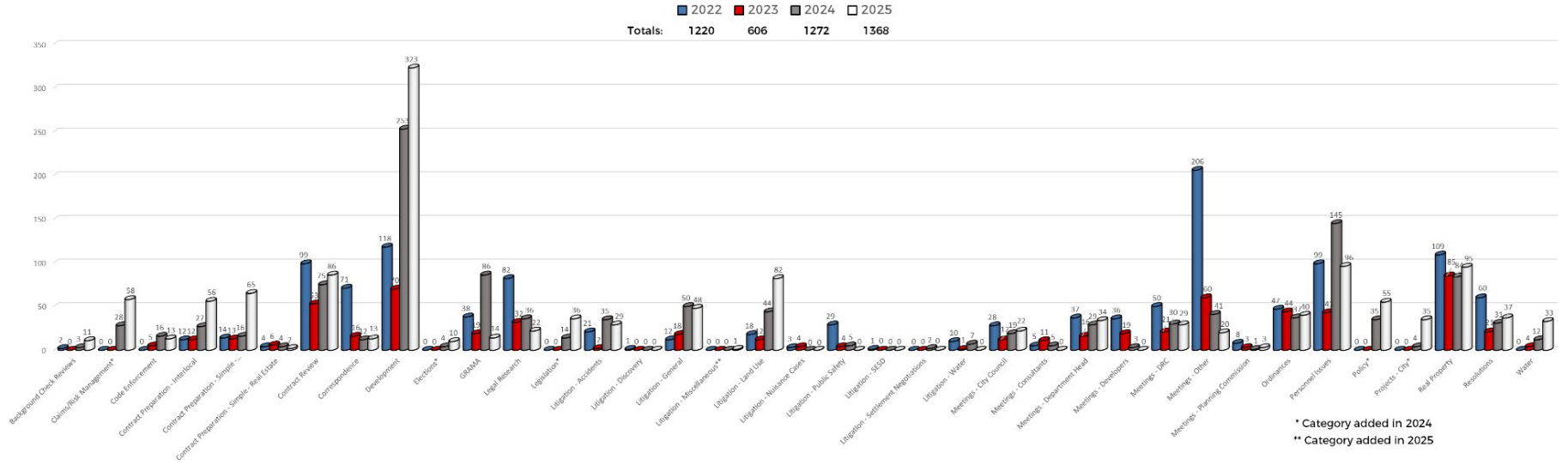

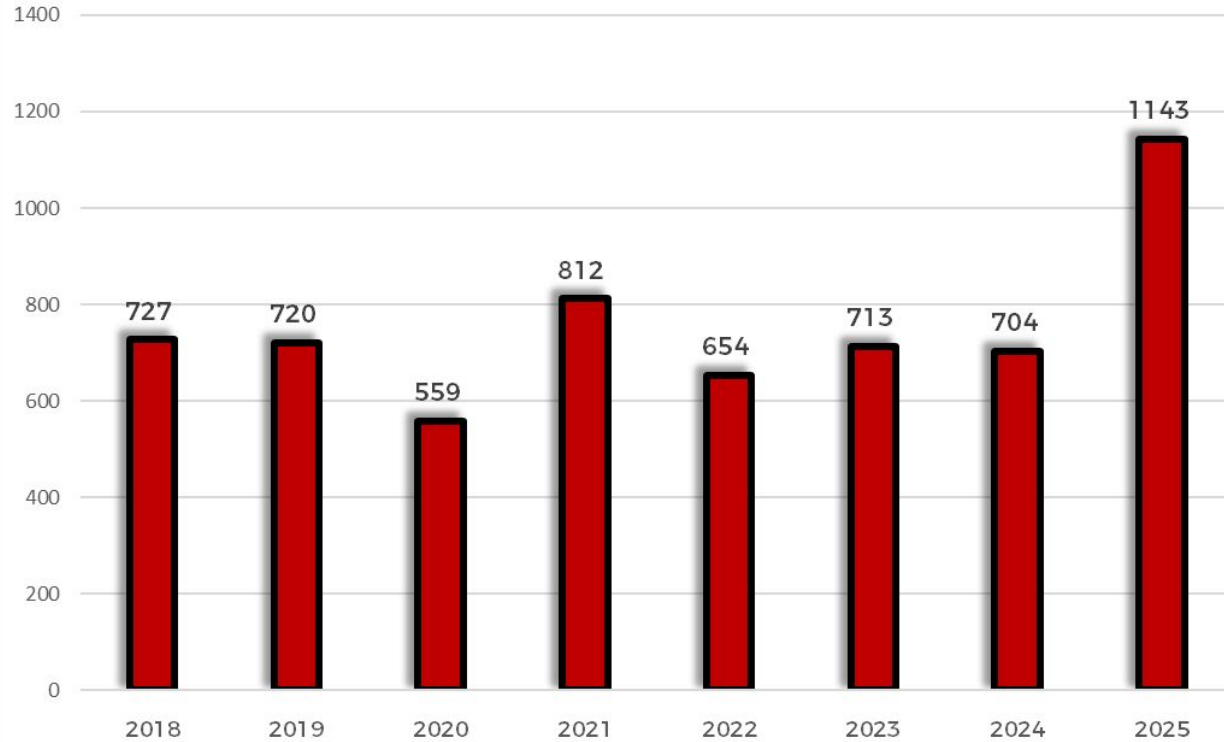

Why trademark?

1. Protect our unique slogans and event names.

3. Indicate official activity, programs, and communication.
4. Use TM to indicate trademark and intent to register.
5. Use ® after trademark has been registered.
