

1. 2026 Utah Legislative Session – AI Bills

 - Adds a requirement for LEAs to have an AI policy or adopt a model policy that USBE will create.
 - Allows LEAs to create an AI course in high schools for AI

2. IHC / USBE AI Professional Development Program Updates

- a. USBE's grant funded training will transition to a new model centered on whole school training in Spring/Summer 26. This program will partner with the Utah Teacher Fellows to identify schools to train from a wholistic standpoint starting with administrators to train teachers and then teachers to provide support for parents. This program will start recruitment in late February.
- b. The school will be funded for their participation in the program on a per faculty member model through DonorsChoose.
