

MINUTES OF THE STUDY SESSION – JANUARY 27, 2026

The Board of Education of the Alpine School District met in a study session on Tuesday, January 27, 2026, at 4:00 PM. The study session took place in the boardroom at the Alpine School District office.

Board members present: Board President Julie E. King, Vice Presidents Stacy M. Bateman and Emily B. Peterson, Sarah L. Beeson, Dr. Mark Clement, and Ada S. Wilson. Absent: Joylin Lincoln.

Also present: Interim Superintendent Robert W. Smith, Business Administrator Jason Sundberg, and members of the administrative staff. There were approximately 20 others in attendance.

Community Outreach Coordinators

Cassey Saxton, Jessica Stauffer, and Alyson Madsen from the Community Outreach Leadership Team presented to the Board of Education on the district's community outreach programs and processes. They outlined the team's mission and purpose, emphasizing their efforts to address the physical, mental, and emotional needs of Alpine students and their families. The presentation highlighted the program's four (4) pillars, available resources for students and families, collaboration with community partners, and shared several notable success stories. The team reviewed the PFSS Grant, which targets a group of schools in Orem, and discussed the Logic Model used to outline the grant's resources, strategies, objectives, and expected outcomes.
