MANAGERS FIELD REPORT

FEBRUARY 11, 2026

While January is still a slower month for us here, we keep busy. I have hired our summer seasonal employees, and it looks like we will have one new employee and three experienced/returning employees. I am excited about our returning employees as they have multiple years of doing the work and I know that I can trust them.

We have received and paid for our adulticide, and I will be ordering the rest of our pesticides in the coming weeks. My plan is to have everything arrive before we go to the AMCA meetings. Last week I was able to attend the West Central meeting held in Grand Junction Colorado. It was a good meeting where presenters discussed everything from pesticide resistance to AI mapping of storm drains. Both of those presentations were worth the trip.

Janae has been mostly working on our agreed upon procedures (audit) and we are almost finished with it. Normally our auditor is not available until May at the earliest so to have it mostly finished before summer is going to be nice. With the Utah Legislature currently in session, I have been busy keeping track of the many bills that will affect special districts and especially those that will affect mosquito control.

And finally, I sold our two segway scooters. We had seven bids on one of the scooters and eight bids on the other. We received a total of \$830.00 for both scooters. \$425.00 for one and \$405.00 for the other. I had two reasons for the sale, the first one being that the scooters have been discontinued by Segway and parts would become hard to find. Also, we needed an upgrade. I have already replaced the scooters with a couple of E-Bikes that have arrived.

So, as I said, it has been a busy month. There is still plenty to do before the mosquitoes start to show up and with a small taste of winter this week, we may have a few.
