### 2. Consideration of Amicus Brief for the congressional district litigation before the U.S. District Court for the District of Utah

**MOTION:** President Adams moved that the Legislative Management Committee direct the legislative general counsel to file an amicus brief on behalf of the Legislature in the matter of Powers Gardner vs. Henderson, the congressional district litigation before the U.S. District Court for the District of Utah. I further move to authorize an amicus brief on the case if it is heard in any appellate court, including the United States Supreme Court, and that the legislative general counsel consult with the President and Speaker as representatives of the Legislature on any necessary matters relating to the amicus. The committee discussed.

The motion tied with a vote of 8 for and 8 against. Based on the statutory authority of Utah Code 36-12-6(2)(e), President Adams and Speaker Schultz cast an additional yea vote to break the tie. The motion passed with a vote of 8 - 8 - 0.
