

Resolution No. 2026 - 01

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR COLLECTION OF DELIQUENT WATER ACCOUNTS

WHEREAS, Honeyville City, Box Elder County, State of Utah, a Municipality, has the responsibility to maintain and operate the Honeyville City Municipal Water System; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Honeyville City has the responsibility for the collection of water accounts, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Honeyville City has the responsibility to provide for the economic operation of the City Municipal Water System,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Honeyville City Council approves the following:

1. When a municipal water account becomes sixty (60) days past due a letter will be sent requesting full payment within fifteen (15) days and notifying the customer that further action will be taken if full payment is not made.
2. In the event full payment is not received, a shut-off notice will be sent to the customer. The customer will be given two (2) business days to clear the account. In the event water service is disconnected for non-payment of account, the account must be paid in full and a twenty-five (\$25) dollar reconnection fee paid before the water service shall be restored.
3. On any water account ~~sixty (60)~~ **thirty (30)** days past due, an interest charge at the rate of one and one half (1 ½) percent per month from the past due date until paid in full will be assessed.
4. All water customers shall be subject to this procedure. However, the Mayor may adjust the account upon showing of a special need.
5. Cashier check or cash will be required in the event of Honeyville City receiving a NSF check.
6. **In the event a renter leaves an account with an outstanding balance, the water will be shut off, and the property owner will be responsible for paying that balance, along with all fees assessed to the account, to have the water service restored.**
7. **This Resolution repeals and supersedes the provisions of any prior Resolution in conflict herewith.**
