A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF VIRGIN, UTAH, RECOMMENDING THAT A PROPOSED ORDINANCE AMENDING VIRGIN MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 16.8.30.A REGARDING TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES ON FENCES BE REFERRED TO THE PLANNING & ZONING COMMISSION FOR REVIEW AND RECOMMENDATION

WHEREAS, pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 10-1-201, Virgin Town is a Utah municipal corporation and political subdivision of the State of Utah; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 10-3b-401, the Virgin Town Council is the legislative and governing body of the Town; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 10-9a-103(30), the Town Council is also the Land Use Authority vested with the power to enact land use regulations and make land use decisions within the Town unless delegated; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council is considering a proposed ordinance amending Section 16.8.30.A of the Virgin Municipal Code to provide an exception allowing traffic calming measures on fences to be located solely on the owner's property; and

WHEREAS, Utah Code Title 10, Chapter 9a (Municipal Land Use, Development, and Management Act) contemplates review and recommendation by the Planning & Zoning Commission prior to adoption of amendments to land use regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds it appropriate and in the best interest of the health, safety, and general welfare of the Town to obtain review and recommendation from the Planning & Zoning Commission prior to taking final legislative action on the proposed ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF VIRGIN, UTAH, THAT:

1. The proposed ordinance entitled:

“AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF VIRGIN, UTAH, PROVIDING THAT THE VIRGIN MUNICIPAL CODE BE AMENDED BY REVISING SECTION 16.8.30.A PROVIDING FOR AN EXCEPTION FOR TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES ON FENCES BEING LOCATED SOLELY ON OWNER’S PROPERTY”

is hereby referred to the Virgin Town Planning & Zoning Commission for review and recommendation.

2. The Planning & Zoning Commission is requested to review the proposed ordinance, hold any required public hearings, and provide its written recommendation to the Town Council in accordance with applicable state law and Town ordinances.
3. Upon receipt of the Planning & Zoning Commission's recommendation, the Town Council shall consider the proposed ordinance in accordance with Utah law.
