

U.S. Route 89

Mt. Carmel Junction to Orderville



The Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) is proposing improvements to U.S. Route 89 in Southwest Kane County. UDOT proposes to construct a 12-foot-wide, paved multi-use trail along the southbound side of US-89 from milepost (MP) 82.5 to MP 85.8, between the towns of Mt. Carmel and Orderville. This multi-use trail will provide connectivity for pedestrians and cyclists to travel safely along US-89. This project was identified in the Long Valley Active Transportation Plan as well as the Long Valley Master Plan and is one of the first projects to be constructed as part of the Statewide Trail Network.

Work Will Include:

- Extensions and upgrades to existing drainage infrastructure
- Utility relocations
- Reconstruction of an existing retaining wall located at approximately MP 82.85
- Temporary construction easements will be obtained to facilitate driveway reconstruction in some areas
