Outside Water Connections requires approval from Castle Valley Special Service District , Cottonwood Irrigation Company, and Orangeville City Council.

ZONING CLEARANCE:

Before applying for a building permit, a Zoning Clearance needs to be done with the Zoning Administrator to make sure all set back, and any other requirements are being met to comply with Orangeville City Code.

BUILDING PERMITS:

Submit to the County

ANIMAL RIGHTS:

If needing animal rights for your property, obtain an application and return it back to the city. A zoning clearance and City Council approval is required for this permit.
