

RESOLUTION 2026-2

A RESOLUTION OF ORANGEVILLE CITY, AMENDING THE WATER AND SEWER FEE SCHEDULE IN RESPONSE TO RATE INCREASES FROM THE CASTLE VALLEY SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, Orangeville City (“City”) provides water and sewer services to residents and businesses within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City contracts with the Castle Valley Special Service District (“District”) for water and sewer services; and

WHEREAS, the District has notified the City of increases in the rates for water and sewer services for the next five years, and utility connection fees and the 2% increase will be effective immediately; and

WHEREAS, Utah Code § 10-8-22, authorizes municipalities to establish and adjust fees and charges for water and sewer services to cover the cost of service; and

WHEREAS, the City Council (“Council”) finds that it is in the best interest of the public health, safety, and welfare to adjust the city’s water and sewer fees to reflect the increased costs to the City and to ensure continued provision of utility services on a fiscally responsible basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of Orangeville City, Utah, as follows:

Section 1. AUTHORITY AND PURPOSE

This Resolution is adopted pursuant to the authority granted by the Utah Constitution and Utah Code, including but not limited to Utah Code §10-8-22, and any other applicable provisions of law, to amend utility fees for water and sewer service.

Section 2. FINDINGS

The City Council hereby finds and determines that:

- A. The District has increased its water and sewer rates for the next five years, utility connection fees and the 2% increase will be effective immediately;
- B. It is necessary to adjust the City’s water and sewer service fees to recover the increased costs incurred by the City as a result of the District’s rate changes;
- C. The fee adjustments are reasonable and necessary to ensure the continued financial stability of the utility enterprise funds; and
- D. Notice of the proposed fee adjustments has been given in accordance with applicable law.

All other fees not specifically amended by this Resolution shall remain unchanged.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE OF RATES

The amended water and sewer fees set forth in Section 3 of this Resolution shall take effect immediately, and shall apply to all bills rendered on or after that date.

Section 5. SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this Resolution is held invalid, unconstitutional, or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.
