GARFIELD COUNTY ASPHALT BINDER

I. Introduction

Garfield County is seeking proposals from qualified contractors to provide asphalt binder required for our 2026 East Fork project. The contractor must supply the necessary equipment and specify potential availability dates in their proposal.

II. Scope of Work

- **Asphalt Binder:** The contractor is required to supply approximately 150 tons of asphalt binder. The final amount will be determined with the contractor once project locations and dates are finalized. The quality and specifications of the binder should be such that it meets the needs of the road conditions and chips that the County will provide. Contractors must provide detailed information on the type of binder they will supply, including its composition, performance characteristics, and any relevant certifications or standards it meets.
- **Binder Requirements**
The asphalt binder must meet the following minimum requirements:
 - Latex modified
 - Contain a rejuvenator suitable for chip seal applications
 - Compatible with aggregate provided by Garfield County
 - Suitable for application under typical Garfield County elevation and temperature conditions
- **Scheduling:** Proposals must include potential dates for the availability of the delivery truck. Contractors should outline their proposed schedule for delivery and application of the asphalt binder.
- **Compliance:** All work must comply with local, state, and federal road work and safety standards regulations.

III. Submission of Qualifications

Interested contractors are invited to submit their qualifications for consideration. The submission should include the following:

1. Company Profile: Overview of the contracting firm.
2. A minimum of three references

3. Estimated cost per ton based on future projections
4. Dates of when the delivery trucks will be available for project implementation.

IV. Required Completion and Acceptance Criteria

Payment for services will be issued within 30 days of receipt of completion of the work and an acceptable invoice. Individual payments may be made as individual tasks are completed. Final payment shall not be made until all work is completed and the required documentation is submitted.

V. Proposal Deadline

Proposals shall be delivered to the Garfield County Courthouse no later than 5:00 p.m., February 27, 2026. Emailed proposals will be accepted.

VI. Number of Proposal Copies and Point of Delivery

Two copies of written proposals or a single copy of emailed proposals shall be delivered to the Garfield County Courthouse, 55 South Main, P.O. Box 77, Panguitch, Utah 84759, Email: dave.dodds@garfield.utah.gov

VII. Proposal Evaluation Process

This procurement is intended to select the lowest priced responsible proposer.

Award will be made to the proposer offering the lowest cost per ton who meets the minimum material requirements and demonstrates the ability to perform the work as specified.

The County reserves the right to determine contractor responsibility, to verify material specifications, and to reject any or all proposals if deemed to be in the best interest of Garfield County.

A proposer may be determined non-responsible if the County finds that the proposer lacks the experience, capacity, or reliability necessary to successfully perform the work.

VIII. Project Management Responsibility

The selected contractor shall be responsible for complying with federal, state, and local laws and shall possess all required licenses, bonds, and insurance.

IX. Disposition of Proposals

Proposals shall become the property of Garfield County and shall be open to public inspection at the Public Works office until December 31, 2026.
