CITIZEN COMMENTS

Shay Morrison, Community Advisor.

Dan Fechner, Jones & DeMille.

Dan updated everyone on the design standards. This will set the standards on new roads for placement of utilities. He is asking for comments from the Council. He suggested the plans be reviewed by the Planning Commission. The city's application to CIB was submitted and accepted for review. A representative from the City should be present at one of the review meetings. Council Member Maxfield said when she had talked to Shay, he had said it would probably be awarded at the April meeting because of the way it was filed. She will need to check with him to make sure. The Transportation Master Plan is just about wrapped up. He would like to be on the March 9th agenda to present it at the meeting. Then later in March a public open meeting would be held where residents could comment on it.

Boyce Sanderson, Request to Purchase strip of City Property adjacent to Gas Hole.

Rocky Mountain Power Street Light LED Program.

Mammoth Water Association.
Mayor Jenkins asked if there was any movement with the agreement. Council Member Clements said Glen had just brought it to her. Mayor Jenkins felt it should be signed for this year and then they can take their time and really review it and decide if any changes should be made for next year. Council Member Davis said he noticed the hose had been installed and wanted to know if the regulator had been. Mayor Jenkins said it was his understanding that there was already a regulator on the fill station it just needs to be adjusted down. Council Member Clements said she and Glen already made the adjustment to the regulator. It does have less pressure than it did before. The type of regulator on the system doesn't gradually turn on and off. It just goes on and off. She thinks the users should be notified of this.
