

CHAPTER 9: DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS WITHIN HONEYVILLE CITY

4-9-1: Discharge of Firearms within Residential, Commercial and Industrial Zones

It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge any firearm within Residential, Commercial or Industrial Zones within the City limits of Honeyville City, except in the following situations: necessary self-defense; by any peace officer in the discharge of his or her duties; or after having obtained prior written approval from the property owner and at least two members of Honeyville City Council or the Mayor.

4-9-2: Discharge of Firearms within Agricultural Zones

It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge any firearm within Agricultural Zones within Honeyville City, except in the following situations: being the landowner, necessary self-defense; by any peace officer in the discharge of his or her duties; or after having obtained prior written approval from the property owner. Individuals must carry written permission from the property owner on their person while shooting on private property.

4-9-3: Penalty for Failure to Comply

Any person who shall fail to comply with the regulations pursuant to this chapter may be subject to penalty as provided in section 1-4-1 of this code.
