1 . Line 24 through 31:

- 24 employee may file an action in a court with jurisdiction under Title 78A, Judiciary and
- 25 Judicial Administration.
- 26 (2) [An]For one year after the day on which the wages were earned, an employee may file
- 27 an action for a wage claim in a court {without exhausting the administrative remedies
- 28 described in Section 34-28-9 and rules made by the commission under Section 34-28-9 }
- 29 if:
- 30 (a) the employee's wage claim is over \$10,000;
- 31 (b) (i) the employee's wage claim is less than or equal to \$10,000;
